## Transport Information:

The Ramada Hotel Micador Niedernhausen and International School Wiesbaden are located in a rural area. Please take note of travel options before arriving.

### **a) Transfer to Ramada Hotel Niedernhausen from the Frankfurt Airport: by taxi**

Approximate cost from Frankfurt Airport to Ramada Hotel Niedernhausen is EUR 60.00.

### **b) Transfer to Ramada Hotel Niedernhausen from the Frankfurt Airport: by train**

#### 1. Train from Frankfurt Airport to Wiesbaden

Take the S9 from Frankfurt Airport to Wiesbaden Main Train Station (Hauptbahnhof)

To purchase the ticket, punch in the number of the destination on the ticket machine for Wiesbaden—6500, after you punch in number this number, push the top left key to purchase a one way, single adult ticket. (Einzelfahrt) (Euros - machine takes notes and coins, ticket desk available).

2. Transfer to a Taxi, destination Ramada Hotel Micador Niedernhausen (taxis are available outside the Main Train Station).

Approximate cost is EUR 25.00 – 30.00.

### **c) Transfer to Ramada Hotel Niedernhausen from the Frankfurt Main Train Station (Hauptbahnhof): by train**

To purchase the ticket, punch in the number of the destination on the ticket machine for Niedernhausen—6475, after you punch in number, push the top left key to purchase a one way, single adult ticket.

This ticket is valid for either the **S2** on lower level, track 103 (destination: Niedernhausen), or the **RB 15174** (Regional train which departs from the main railway station tracks, usually departing from tracks 1 through 4, destination Limburg with stops at Frankfurt Hoechst, Hofheim, and Niedernhausen).

Exit at Niedernhausen and take a Taxi to Ramada Hotel Micador, Niedernhausen.

Approximate cost is EUR 11.00 to 12.00.
