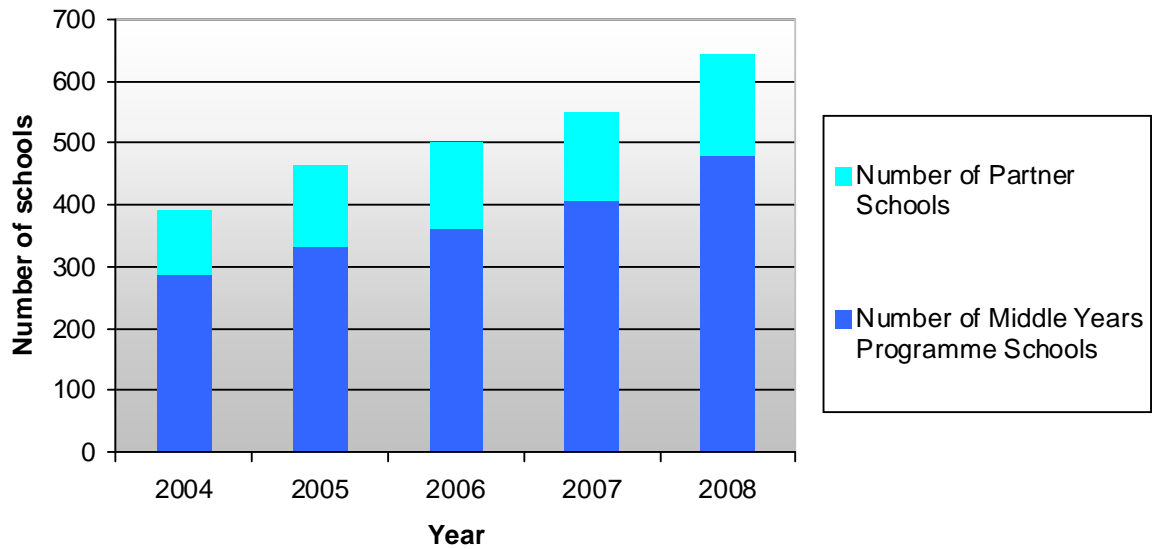

Graph 1.1 Number of schools following the Middle Years Programme 2004–2008

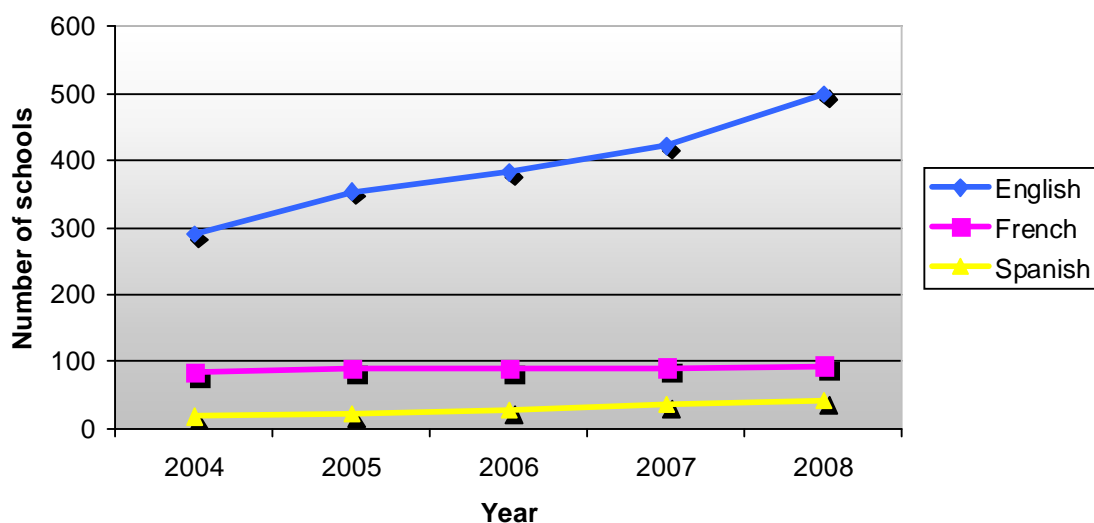

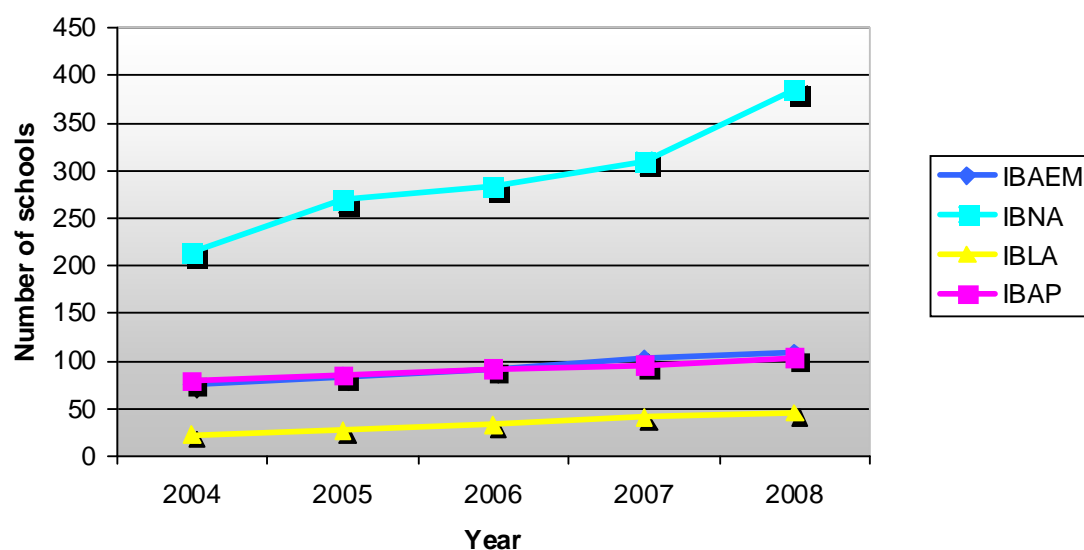

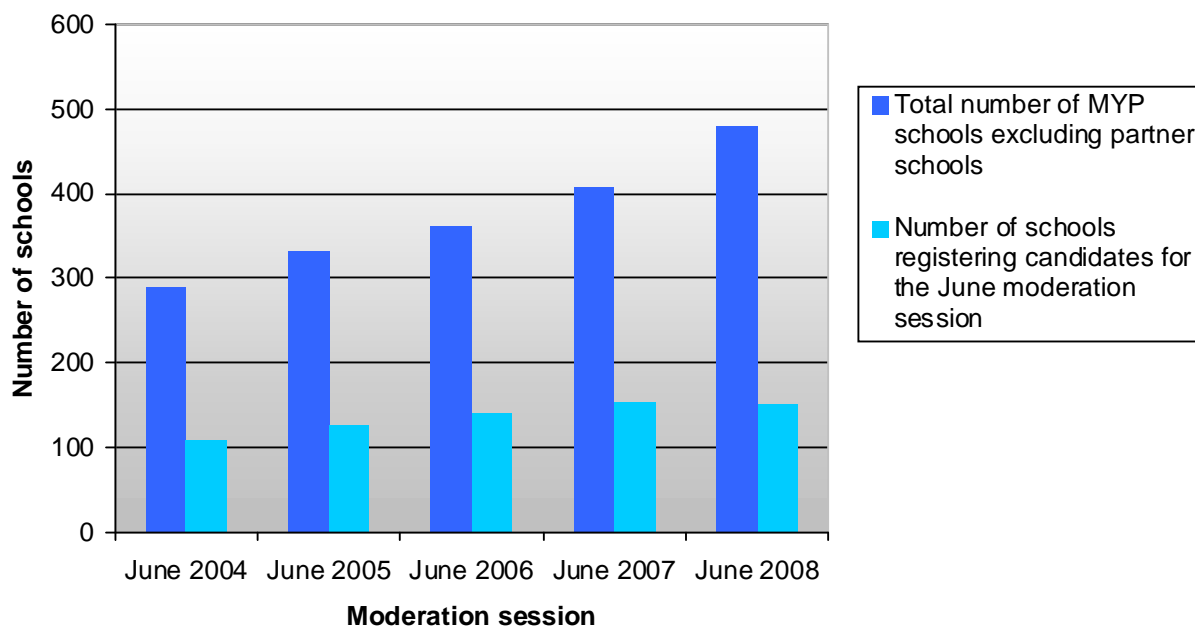

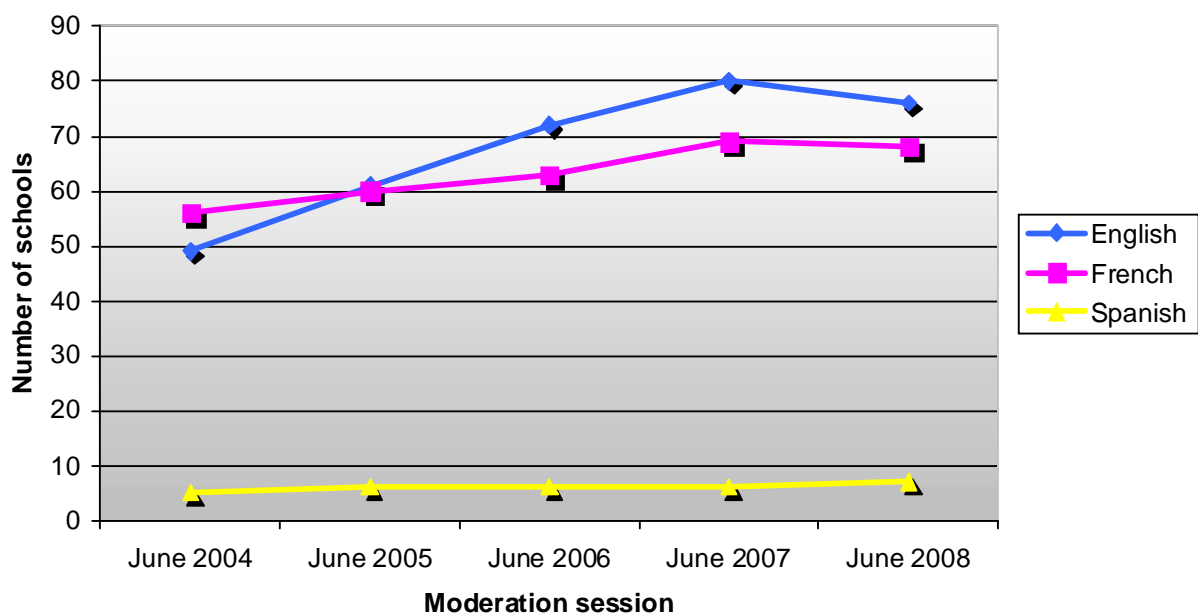
Graph 4.1 Number of schools registering candidates for moderation June 2004–June 2008

Graph 5.1 Number of schools registering candidates by working language June 2004–June 2008

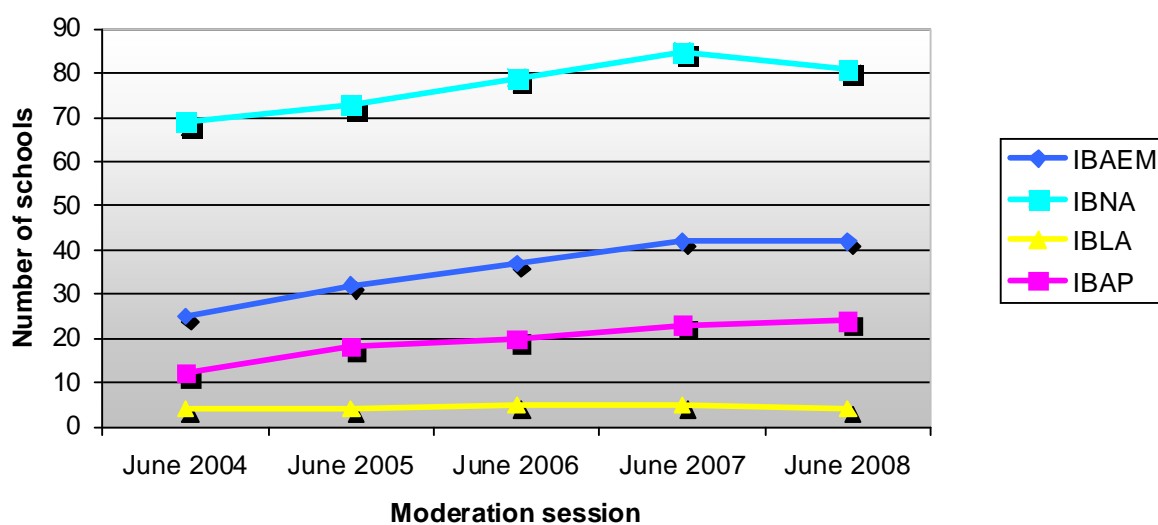

Graph 6.1 Number of schools registering candidates by IB region June 2004–June 2008



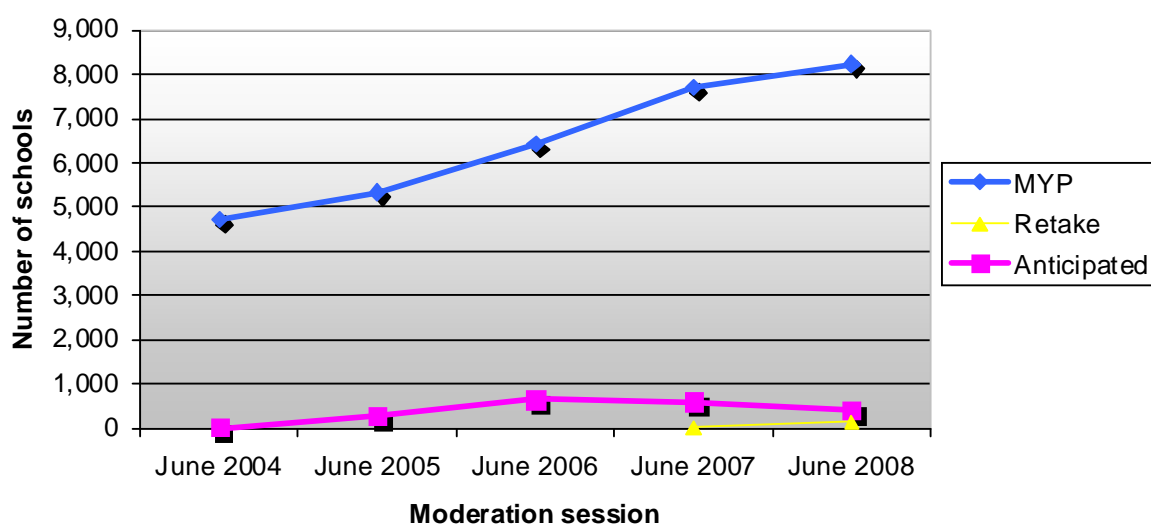

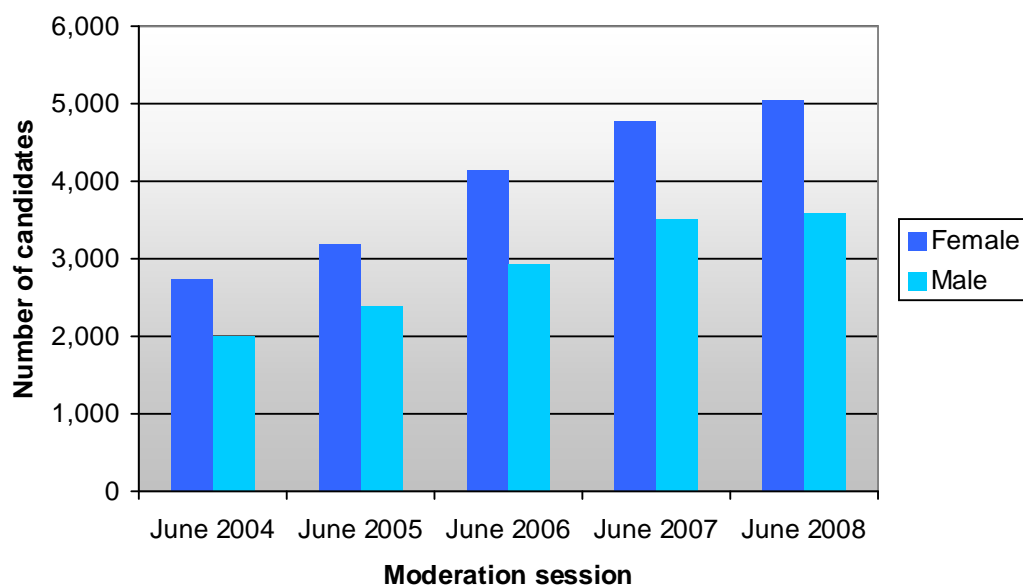
Graph 7.1 Number of candidates registered June 2004–June 2008

Graph 8.1 Number of candidates registered by gender June 2004–June 2008

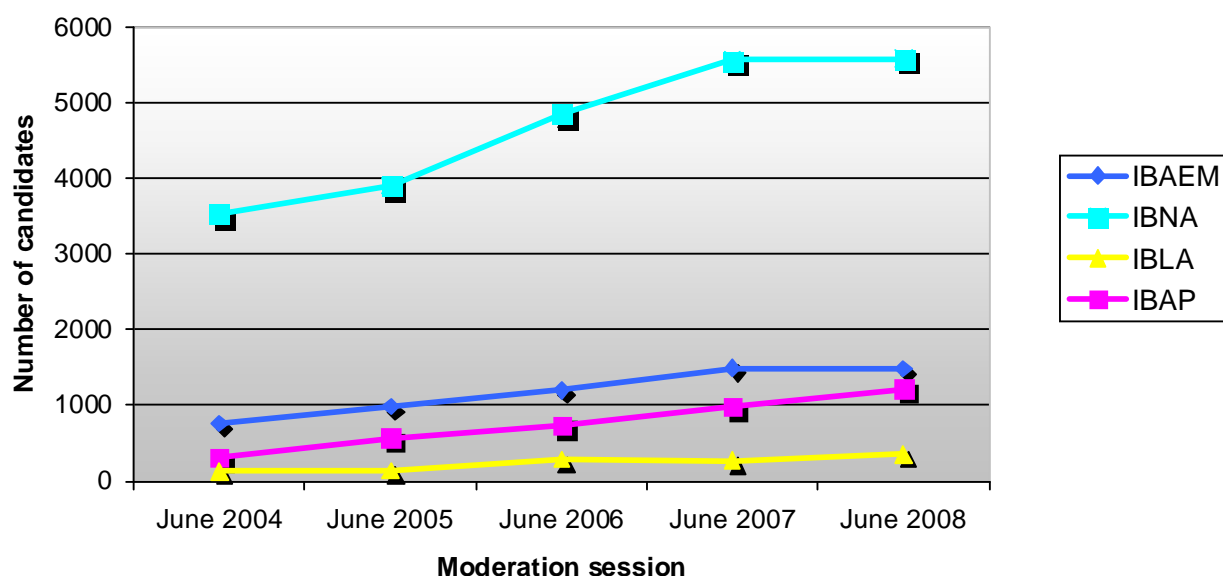

Graph 9.1 Number of candidates registered by IB region June 2004–June 2008

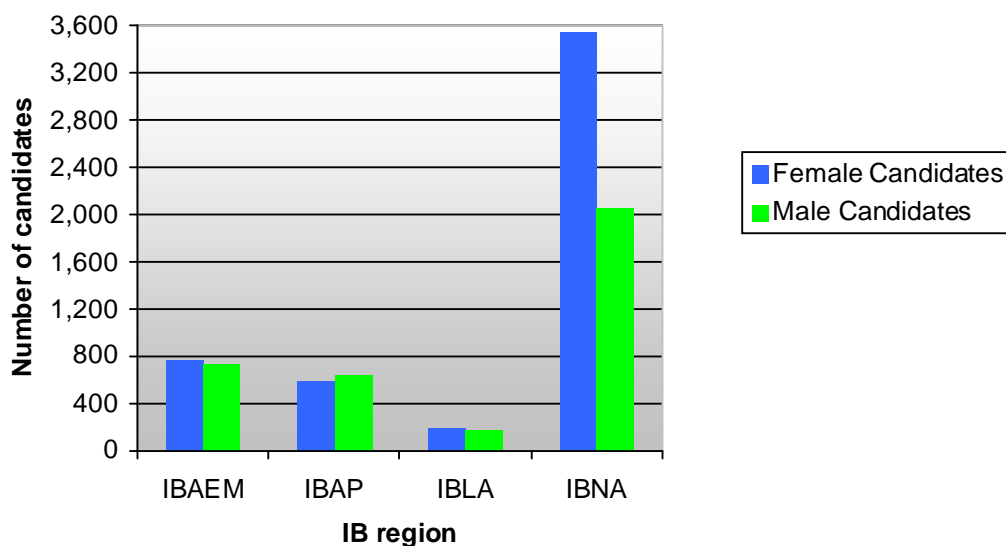

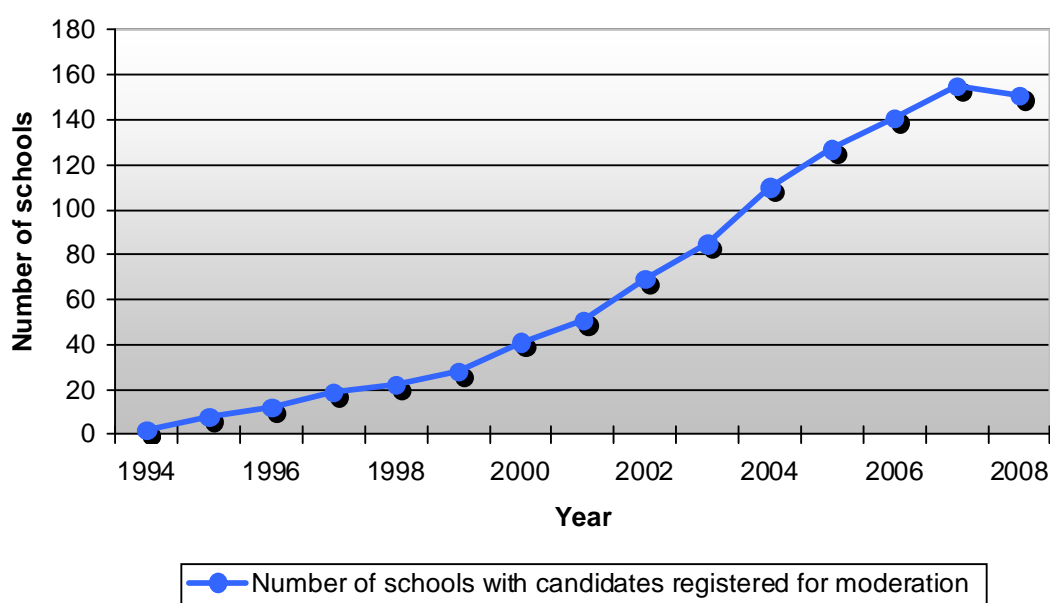
Graph 10.1 Number of candidates registered by gender and IB region June 2008

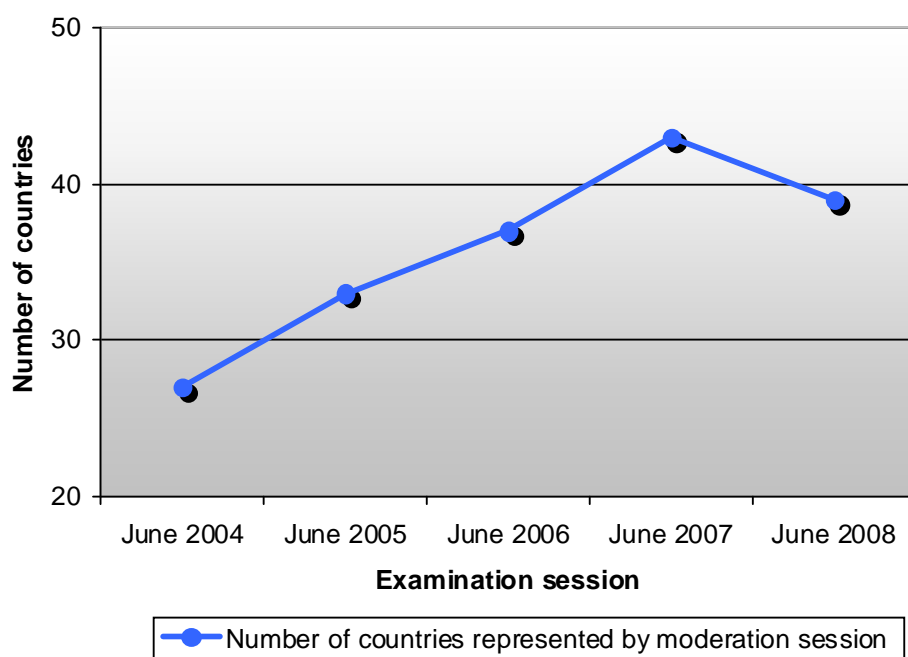
