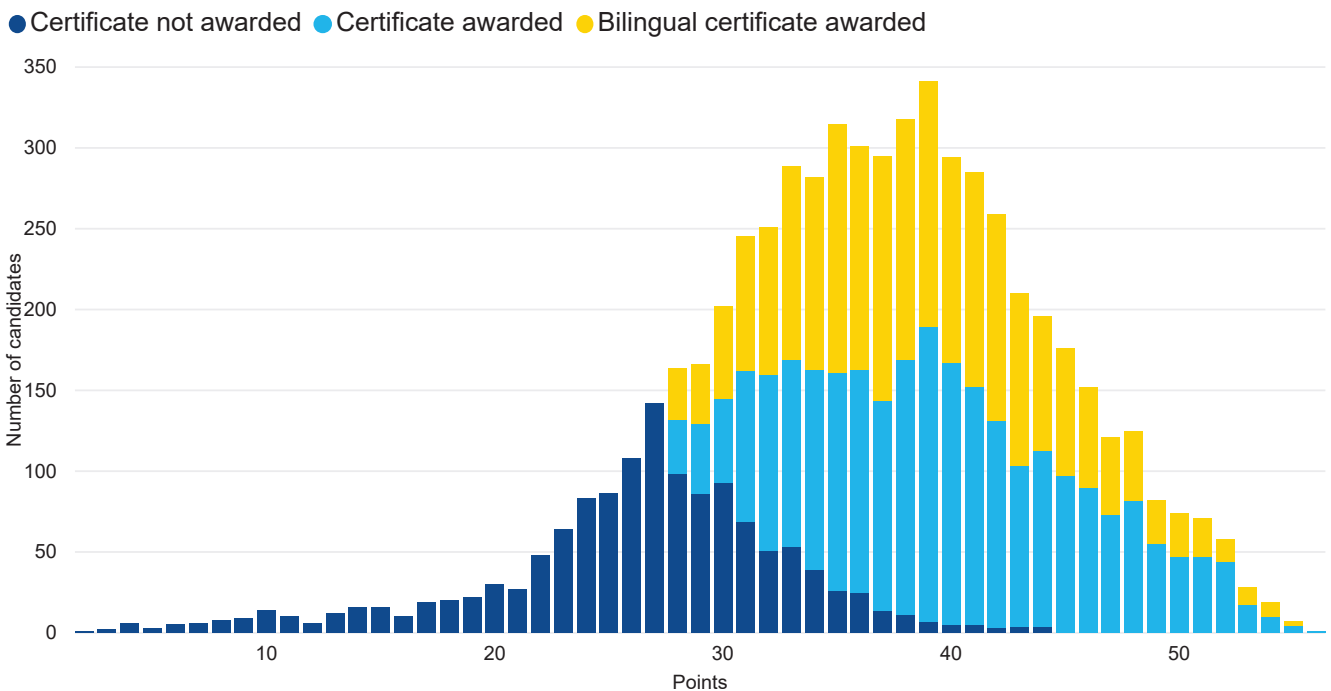

Total points distribution



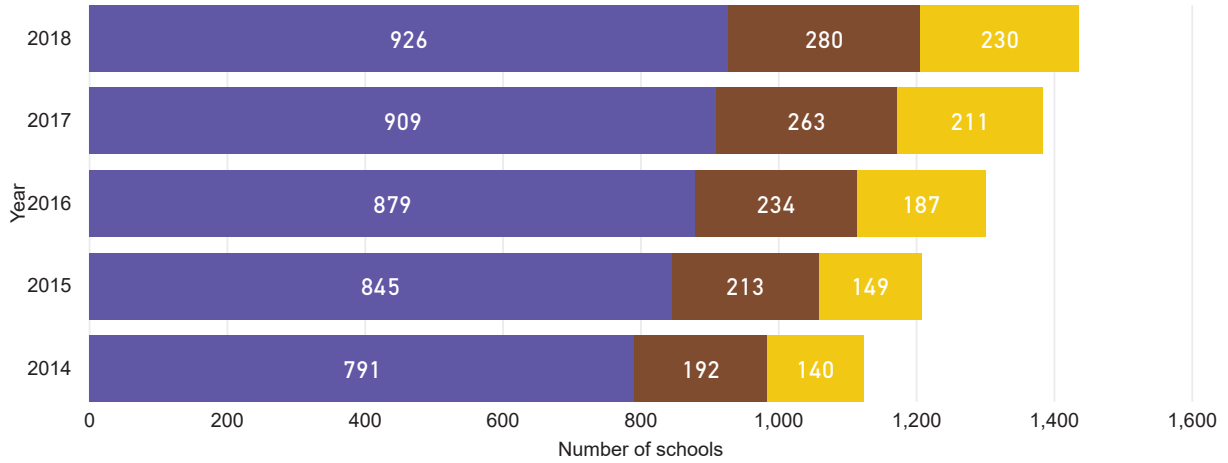

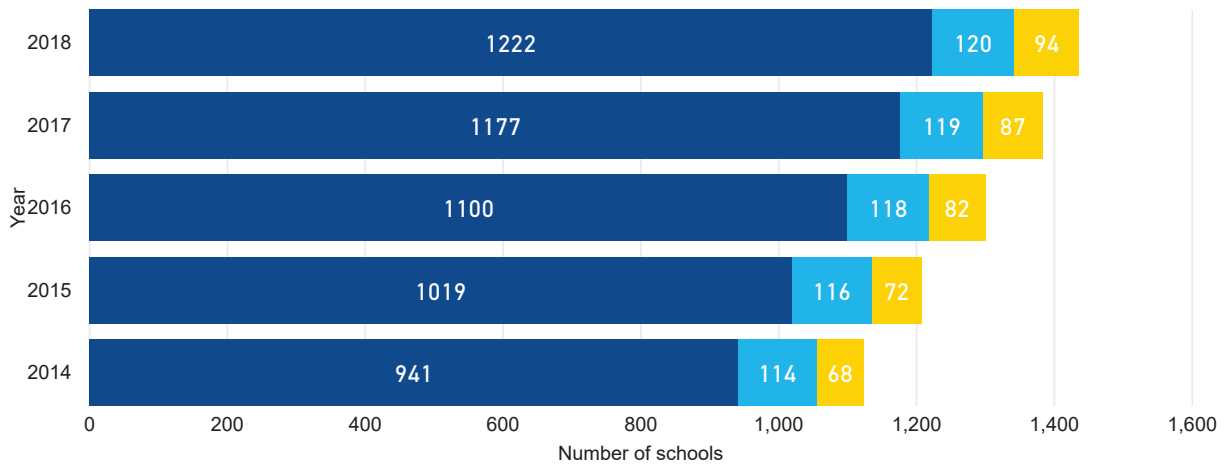
Authorized schools by region

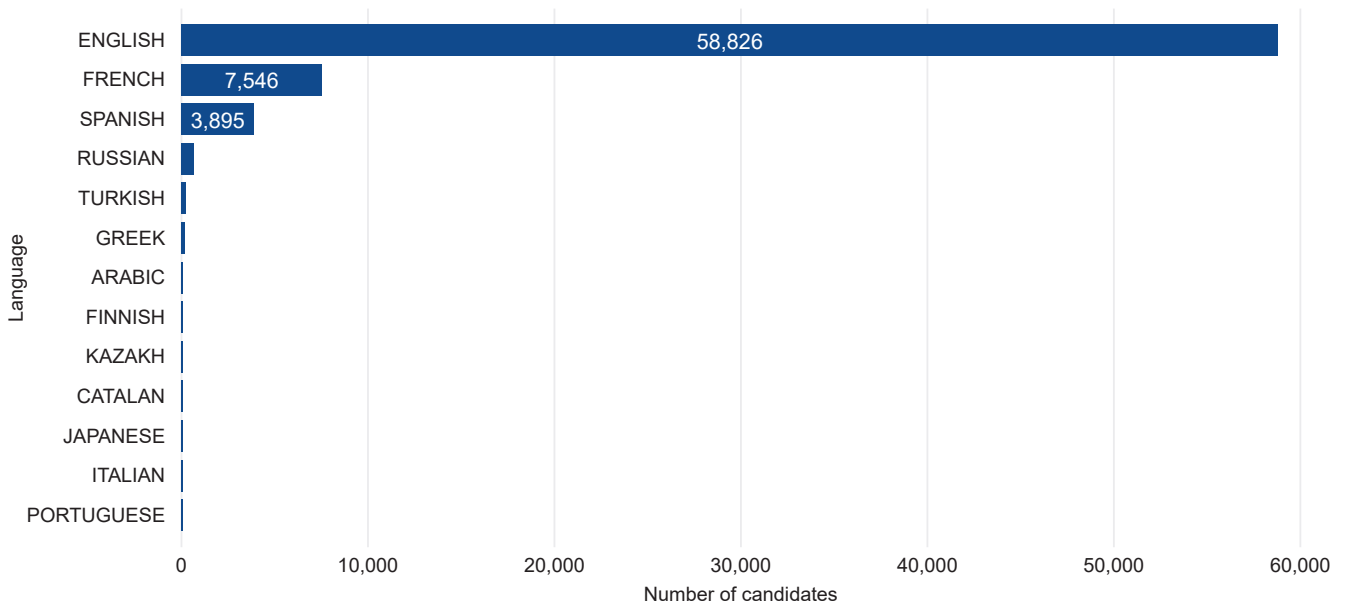


Regional distribution of candidates

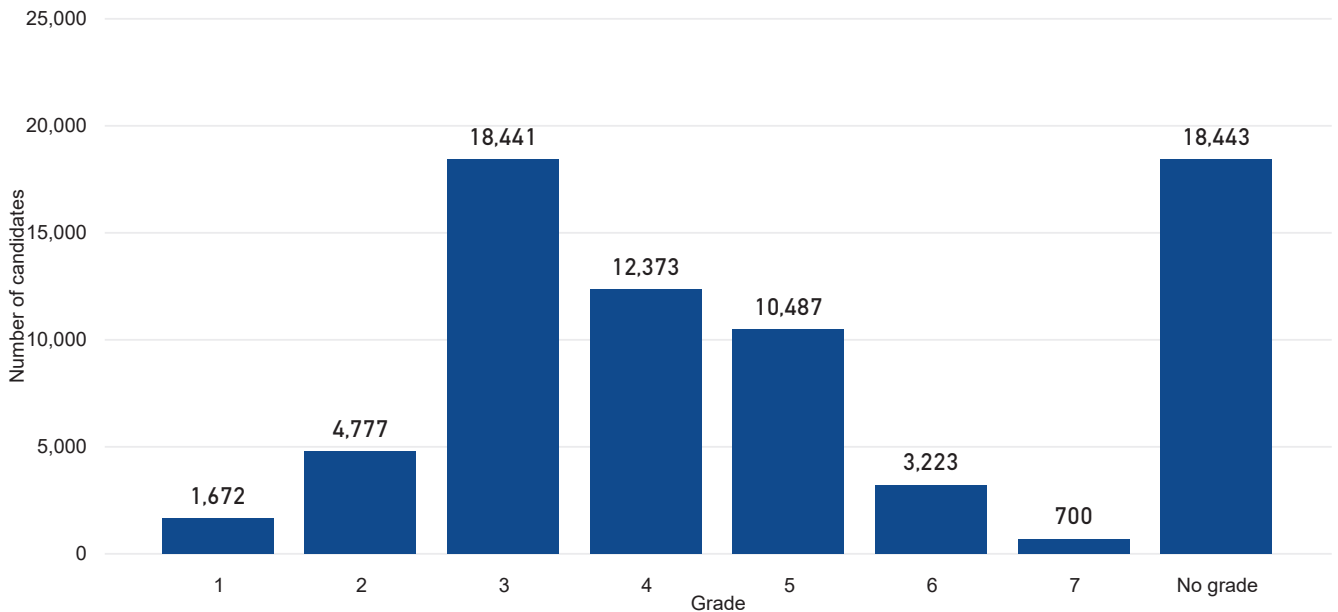
