May 2020 Examination Session

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The IB Middle Years Programme Final Statistical Bulletin, May 2020 Examination Session.

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Due to the global impact and disruption caused by the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak, the International Baccalaureate (IB) made the decision to cancel the May 2020 on-screen examinations as part of the Middle Years Programme (MYP) eAssessment, prioritizing student and teacher health and wellbeing above all else.

For the May 2020 session, the MYP certificate was awarded based on the work for which the IB was able to provide a grade using our normal model of moderation of teacher's internal marking to IB standards. This includes the grades which the student has been awarded in ePortfolio subjects (i.e. design, arts or physical and health education and language acquisition) and the personal project. In addition, we looked at registrations data to check that the student has studied the four subjects usually assessed with on-screen examinations, has prepared for the Interdisciplinary assessment and has fulfilled the programme of learning requirements.

The key changes to the conditions for passing the MYP:

- The requirement for 28 points has been removed.
- The requirement for grades in the on-screen examinations has been removed.
- For each ePortfolio subject and Personal Project a grade 3 or above is required.

Alongside IB-validated results for the personal project and ePortfolio, MYP students received a record of predicted grades provided by schools for the cancelled on-screen examinations.

Due to this year's extraordinary exam session, this statistical bulletin includes data for the May 2020 examination session for the personal project and ePortfolio subjects only. Data on total points are not included in this statistical bulletin.

## Final data

These final data tables represent the outcomes after the close of the examination session. It includes any changes due to Enquiries upon Results and where results have completed from late school submission of information.

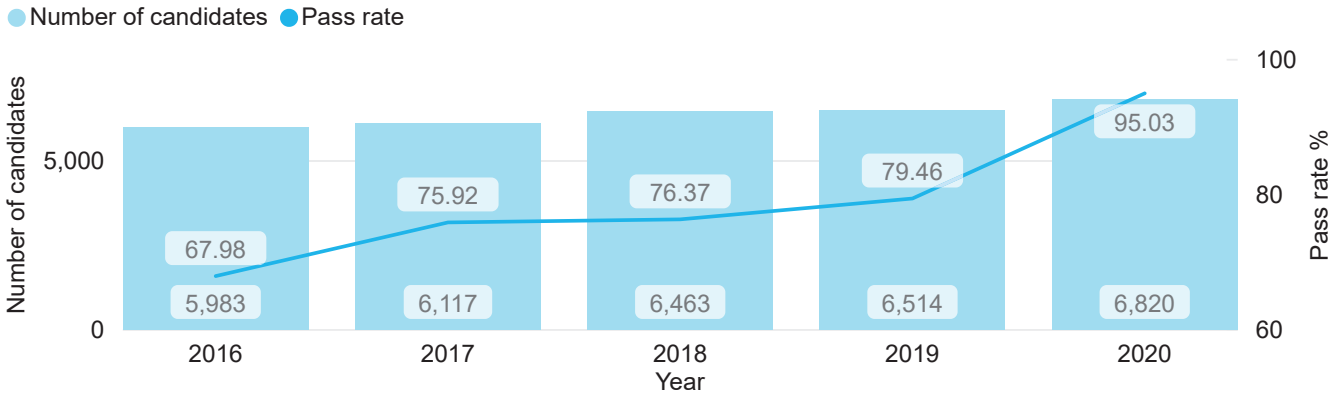
Percentage split by gender

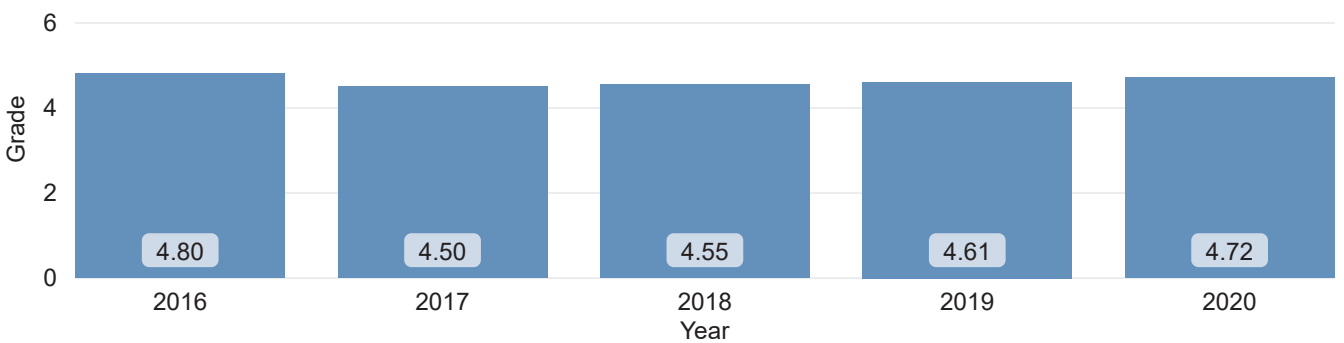
Number of candidates with result issued and pass rate

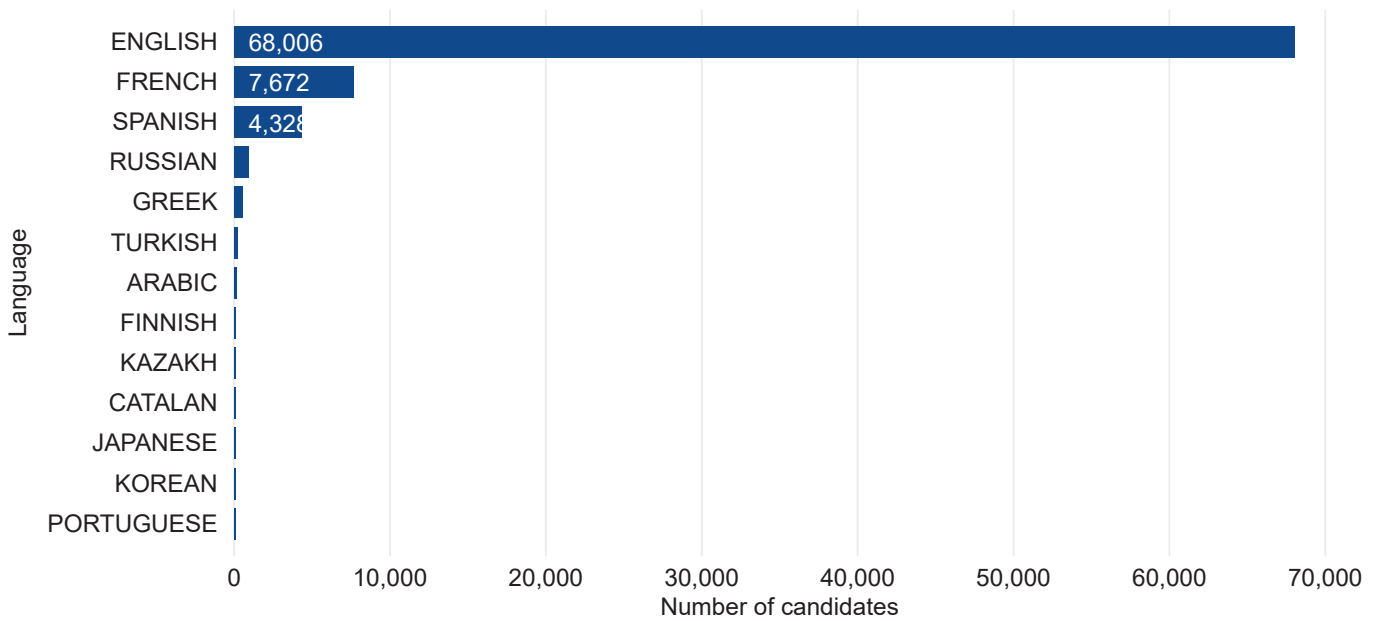


Regional distribution of candidates

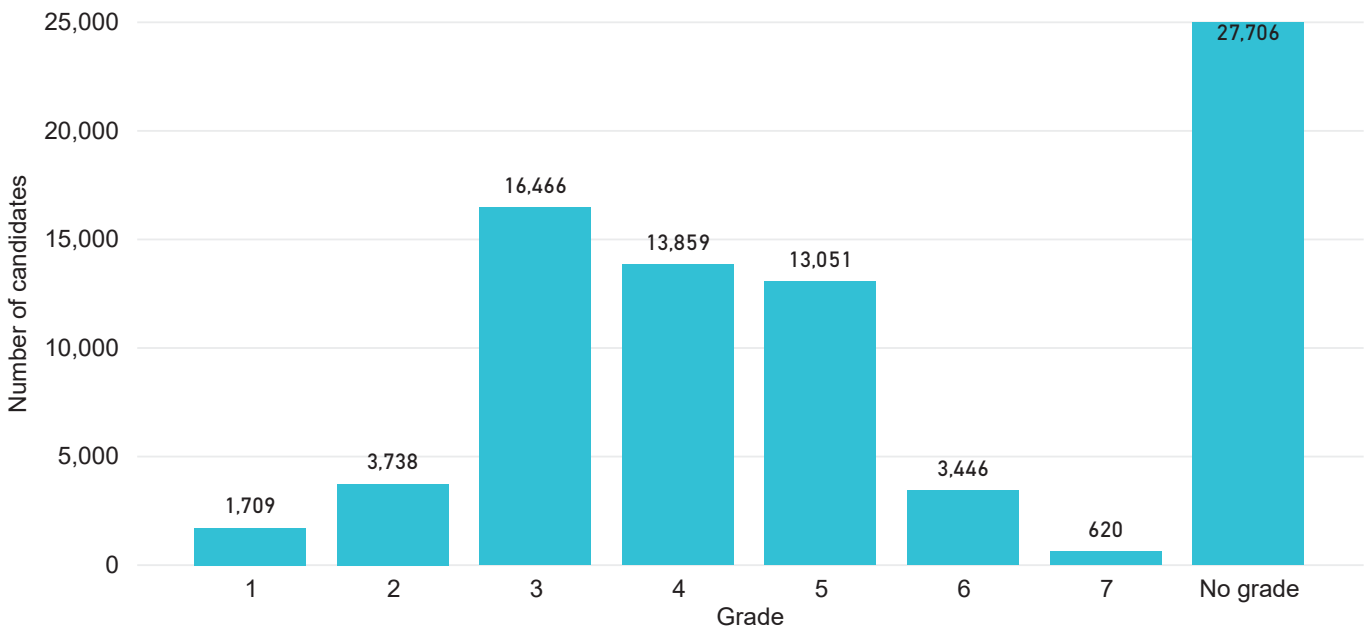

Personal project by language

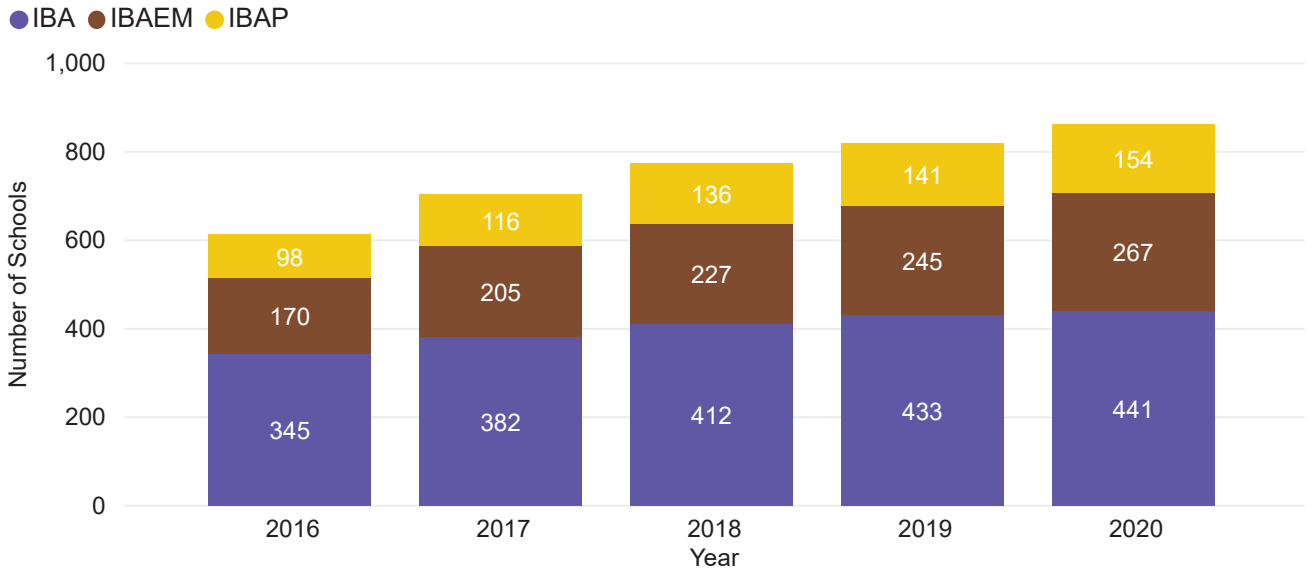


Personal project grade distribution

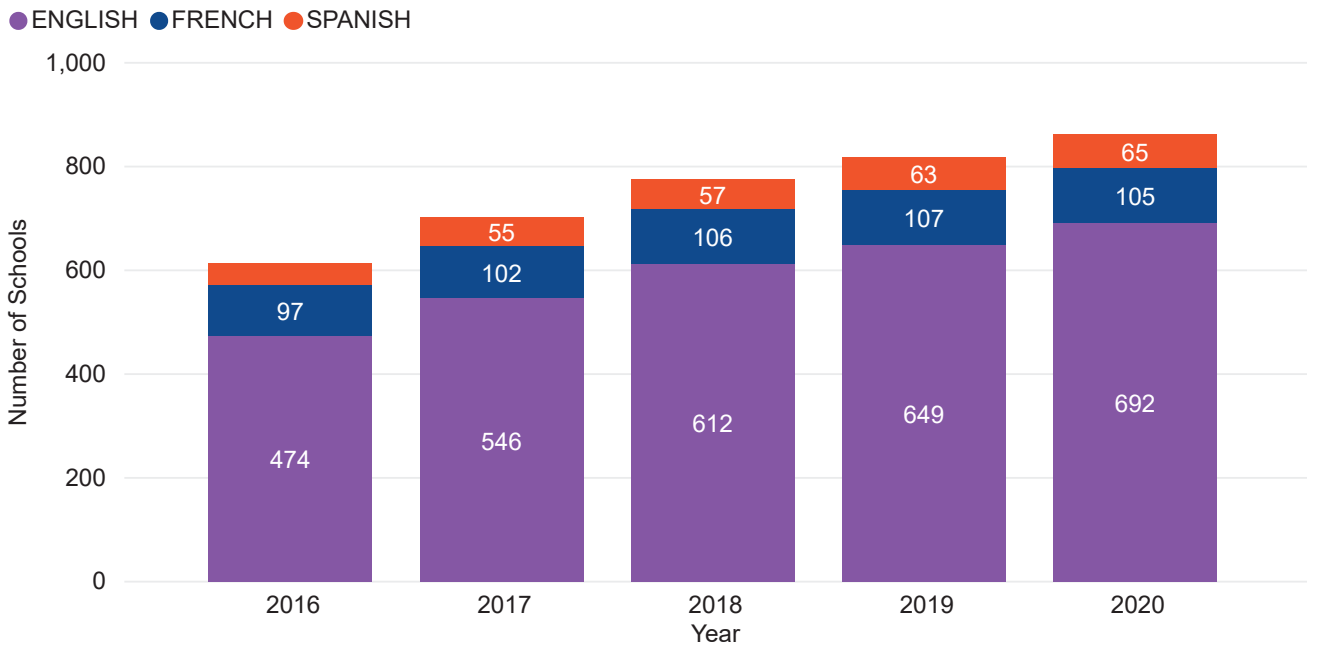
