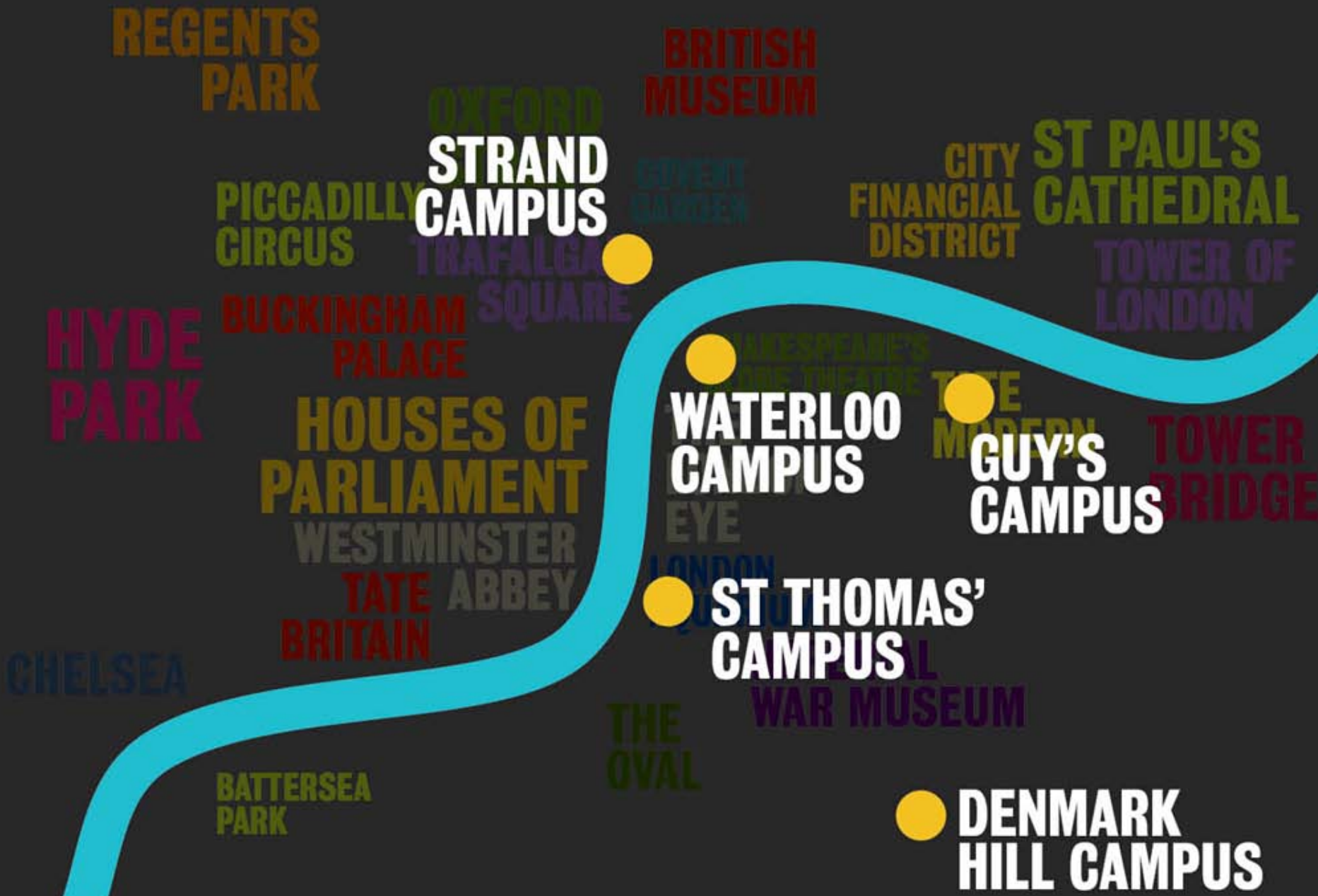

## The IB and admissions to King's

- IB is a badge of authenticity
- If students takes the IB alongside national qualification we will make a double offer
- School and students need to sign up at IBO for results to be send via UCAS
- If students misses the required grades/is below 34, it will take until A-level results to make an offer ( - nature of competitive programmes)
- Reference – if possible link it to the school profile, if possible let us know how good you are in predicting grades
