## Final data

These final data tables represent the outcomes after the close of the examination session. It includes any changes due to Enquiries upon Results and where results have completed from late school submission of information.

### Context for the May 2023 statistical bulletin

Due to the ongoing disruptions as a result of COVID-19 the IB offered two methods for assessment, examinations and non-examination. For the non-examination contingency the IB used the available evidence from teachers on the student achievement; the marked coursework that the student had already completed, the predicted grade from the teacher and evidence on how these two pieces of data usually related to final grades for each school.

The IB has made every effort to ensure parity between the examination and non-examination contingency and recommend all stakeholders to treat them as equivalent. All statistics are based on the combined examination and non-examination contingency.

### Number of students achieving 45 points

From the May 2023 Diploma Programme (DP) and Career-related Programme (CP) assessment session, the statistical bulletin will no longer include data on the number of students achieving 45 points. The IB has made this decision because it values the importance of focusing on the achievements of all students—we are equally proud of all our IB students and the accomplishments they achieved during their two-year DP or CP journey. By presenting the proportion of points in bands of 5, we believe that there is sufficient information for interested parties to understand our standards.

DP Diploma qualification candidates must register in one of three categories:

**Diploma:** Candidates intending to complete the requirements for the award of an DP Diploma.

**Retake:** Previous DP Diploma candidates who are seeking to improve their results by retaking one or more subjects. The highest grade obtained for a subject will contribute towards the DP Diploma.

**Anticipated:** Candidates intending to complete the requirements for one or two standard level subjects (excluding languages ab initio and pilot subjects) at the end of their first year of the Diploma Programme. They must complete all remaining DP Diploma requirements in the corresponding examination session the following year.

CP Certificate qualification candidates must register in one of three categories:

**Career-Related Programme:** Candidates intending to complete the requirements for the award of an CP Certificate.

**Retake:** Previous CP Certificate candidates who are seeking to improve their results by retaking one or more subjects. The highest grade obtained for a subject will contribute towards the CP Certificate.

**Anticipated:** Candidates intending to complete the requirements for one standard level subjects (excluding languages ab initio and pilot subjects) at the end of their first year of the Career-Related Programme. They must complete all remaining CP Certificate requirements in the corresponding examination session the following year.

**Course:** Candidates taking one or more subjects who are not seeking the award of the DP Diploma or CP Certificate.

**DP Diploma Results:** Data includes all Diploma and Retake category candidates whether they were awarded the diploma or not. Unless otherwise stated.

**CP Certificate Results:** Data includes all Career-related programme and Retake category candidates whether they were awarded the certificate or not. Unless otherwise stated.

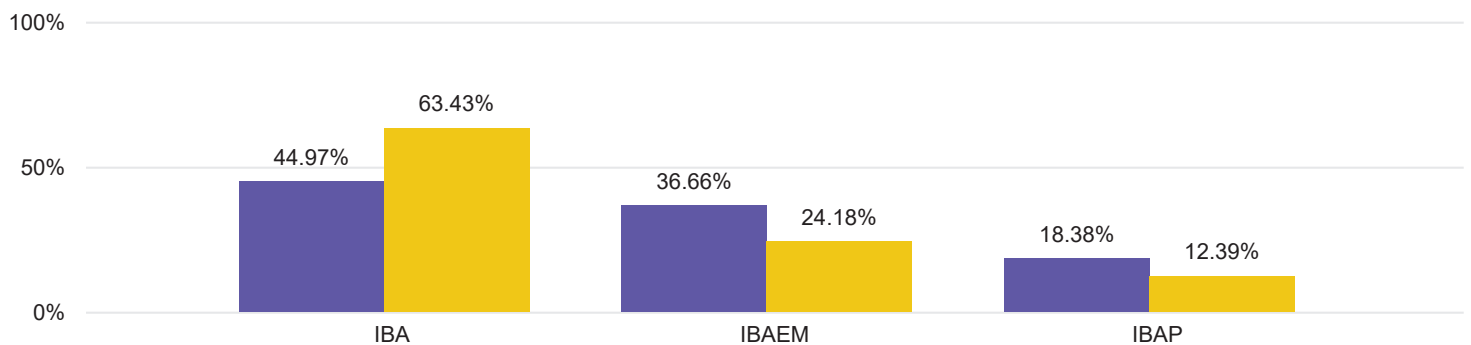
Percentage Split by Qualification

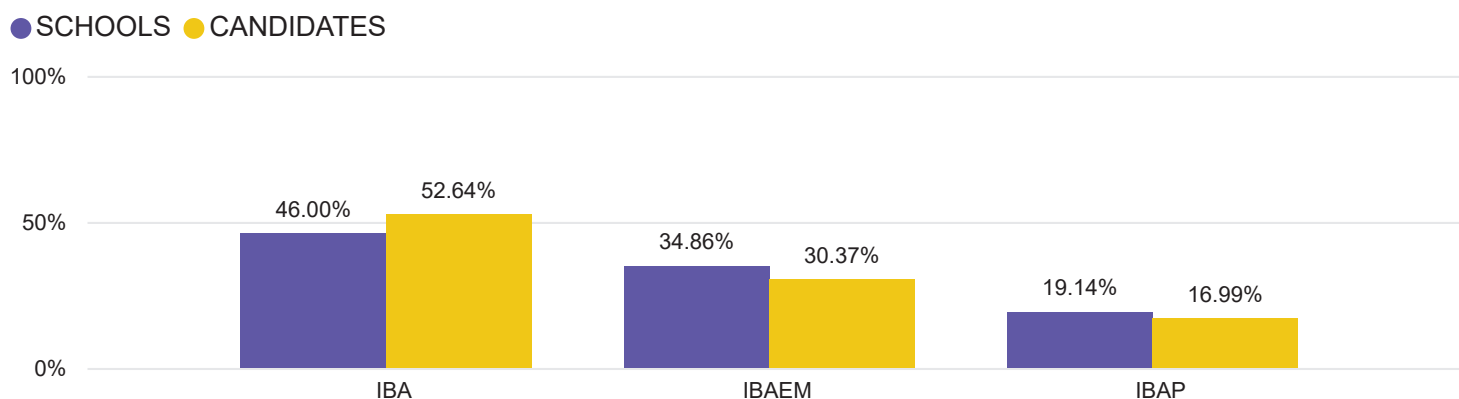

Percentage Split by Category

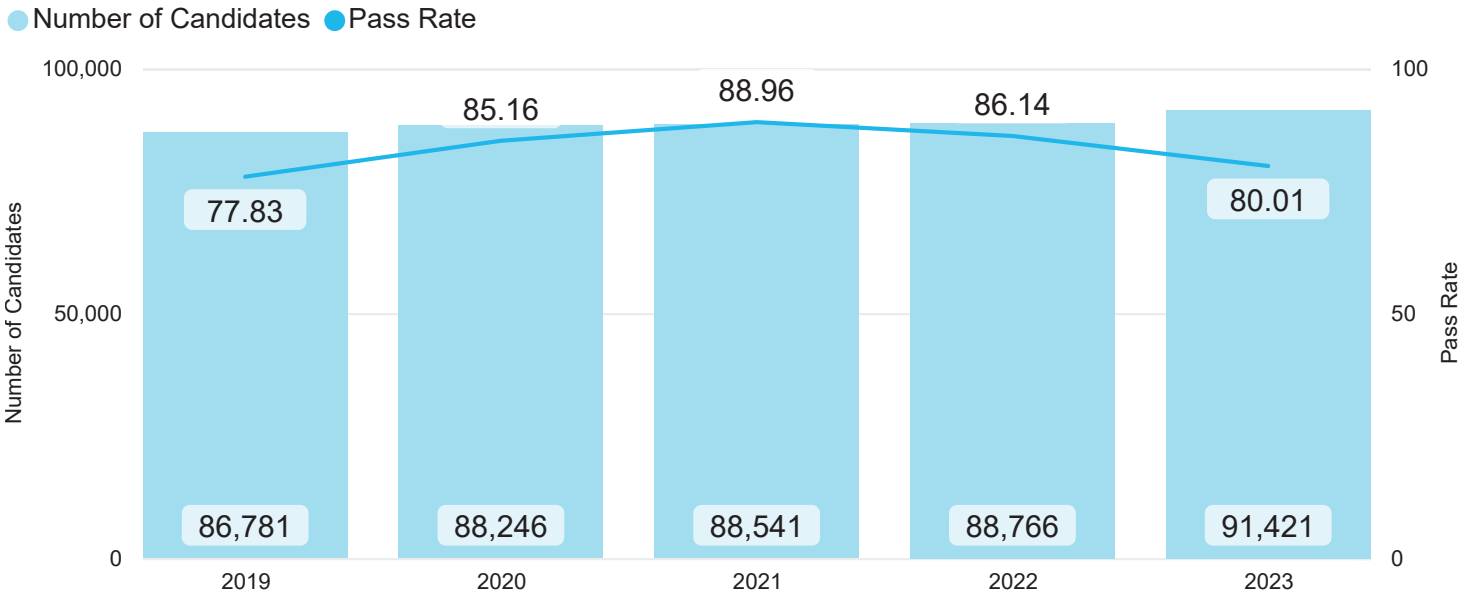


Distribution of Schools by Legal Status

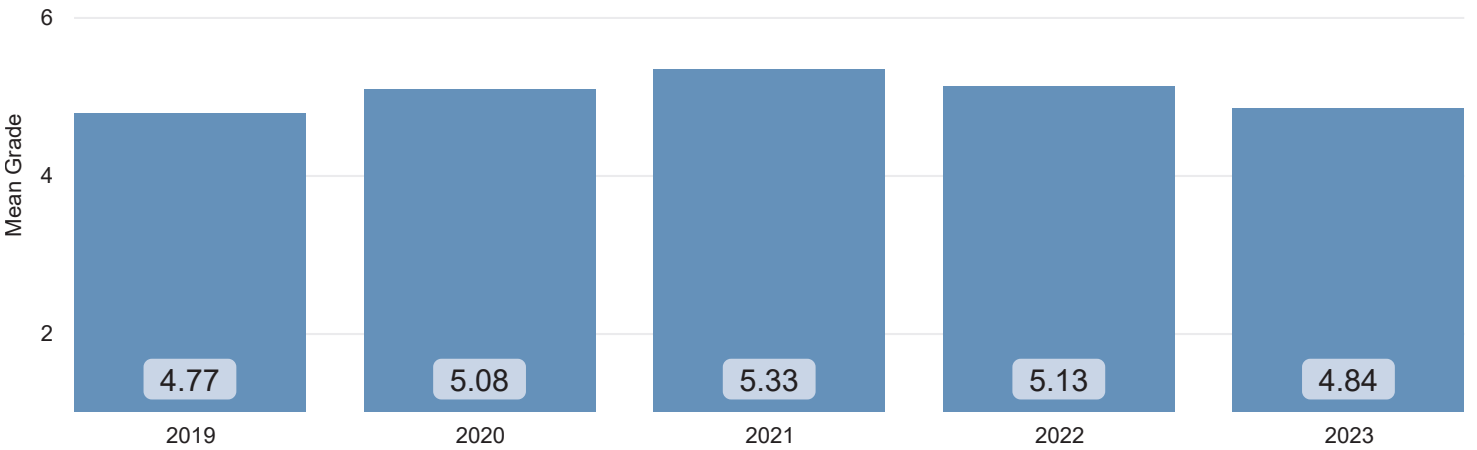

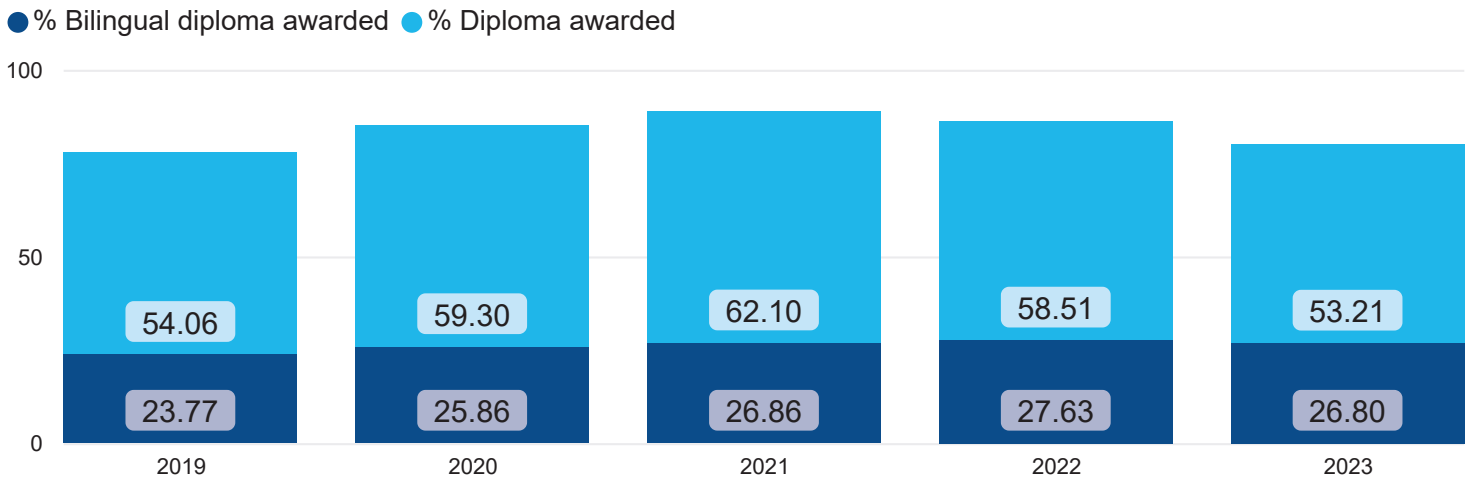
## Number of Candidates and Pass Rate

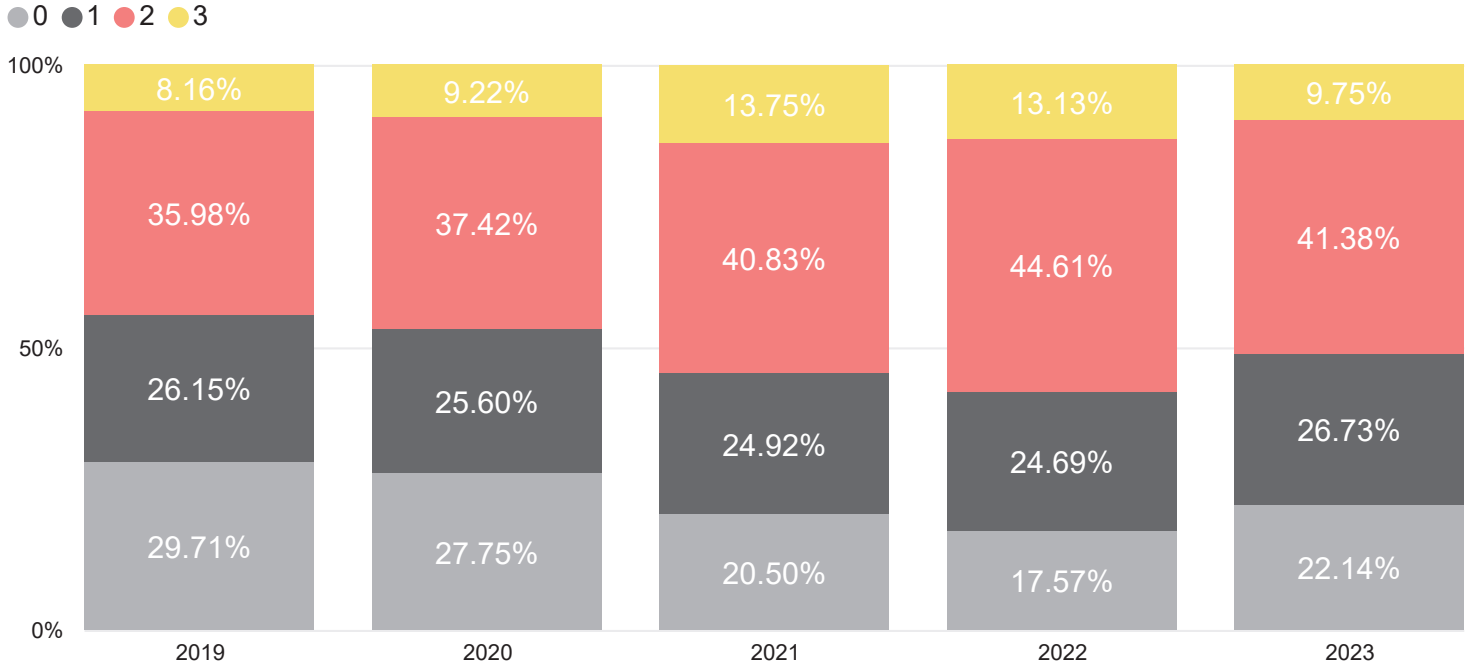

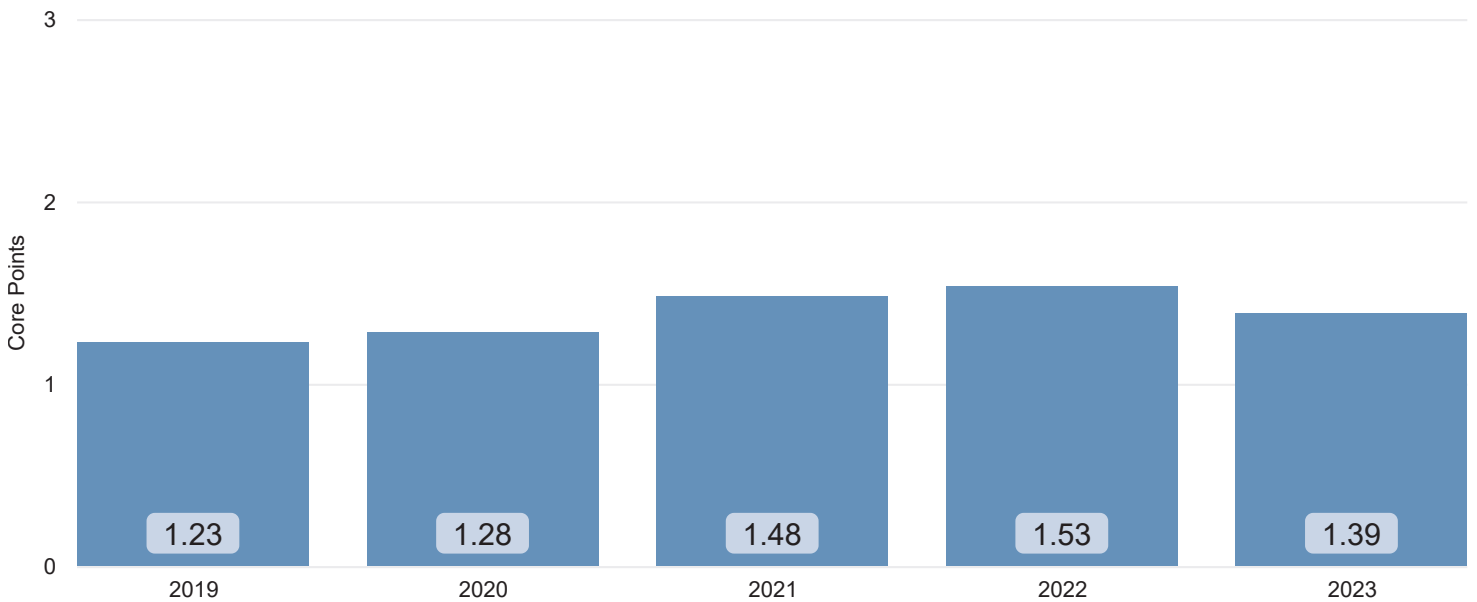

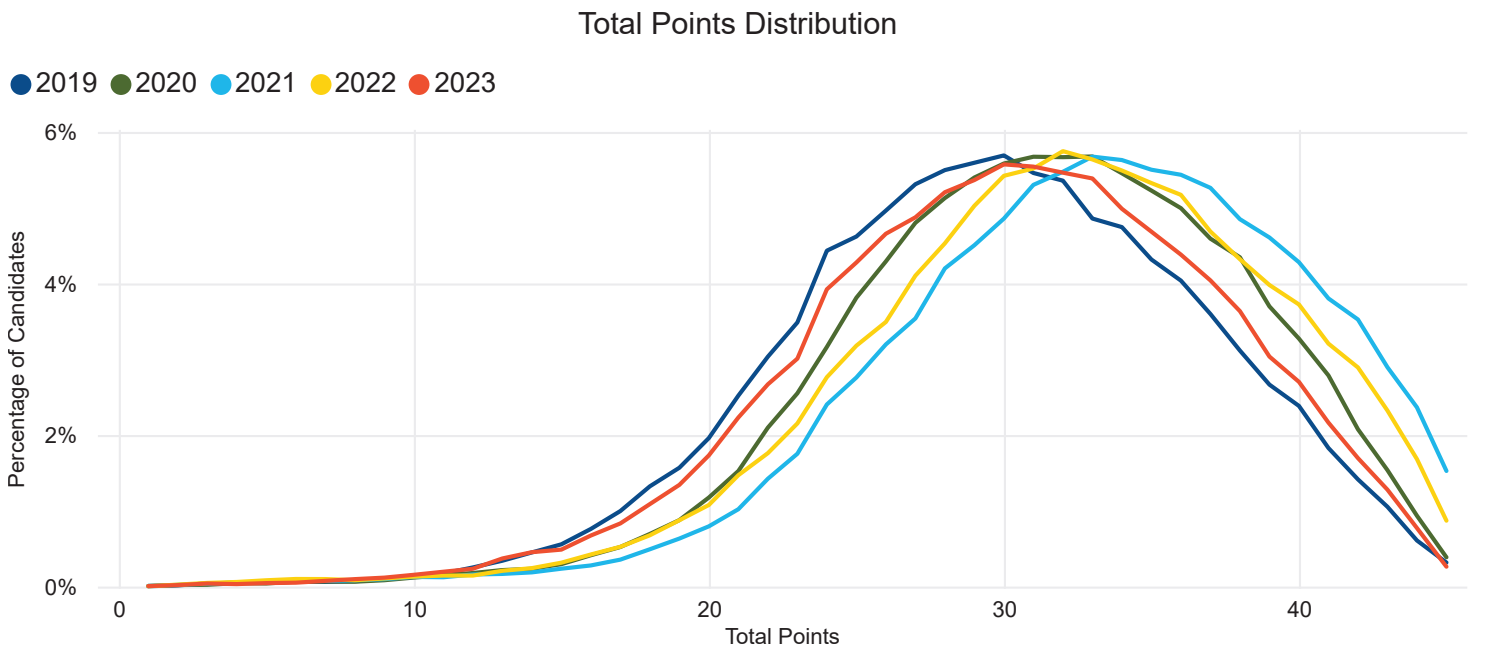
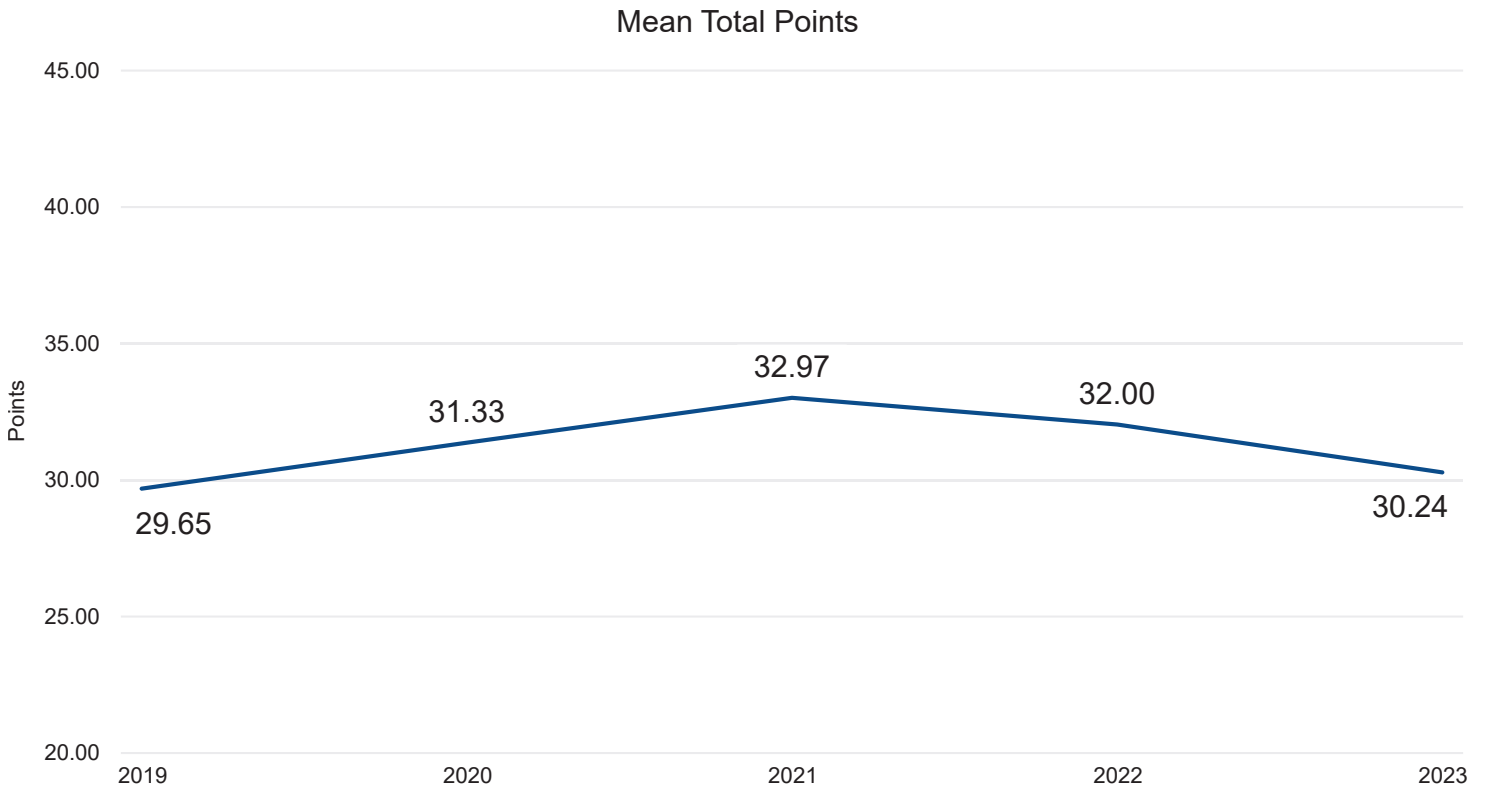
Percentage of Candidates Awarded Core Points

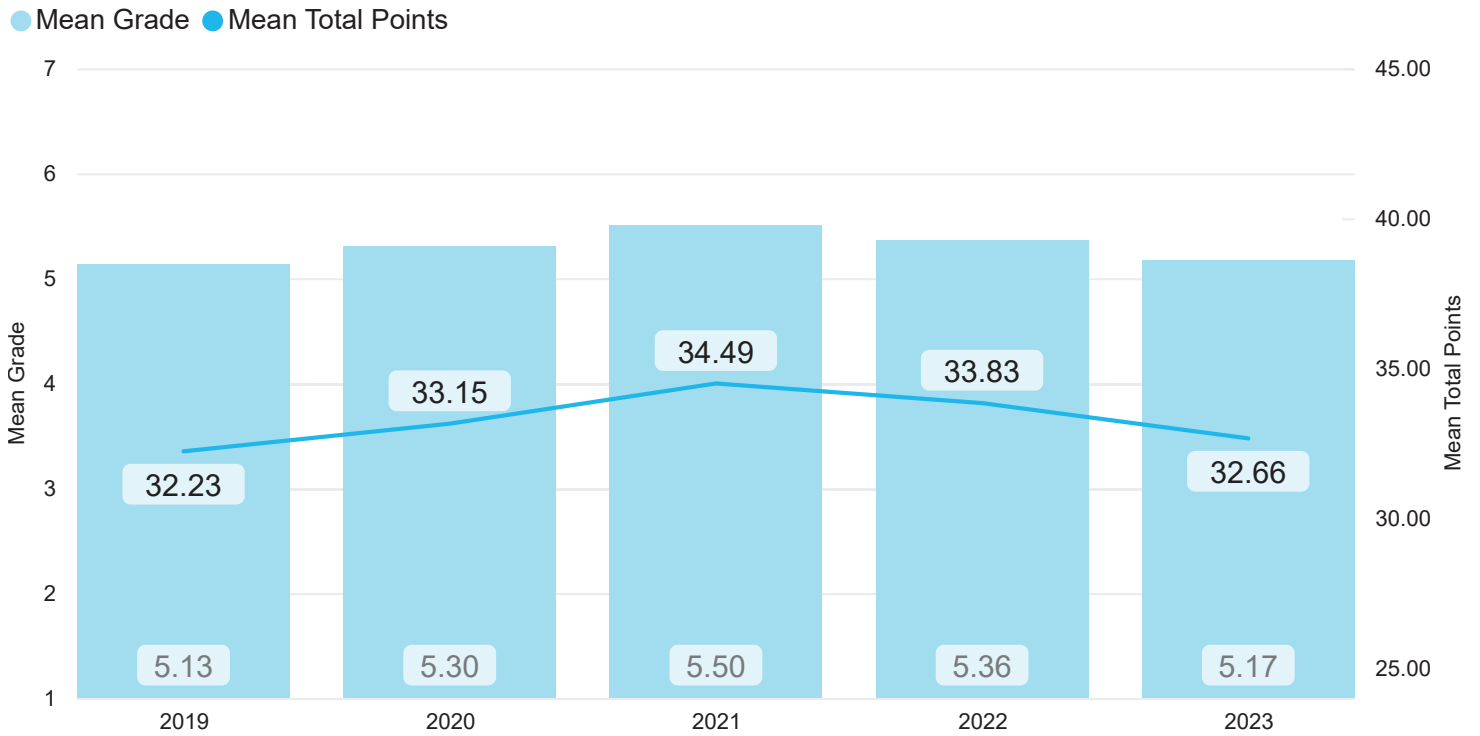

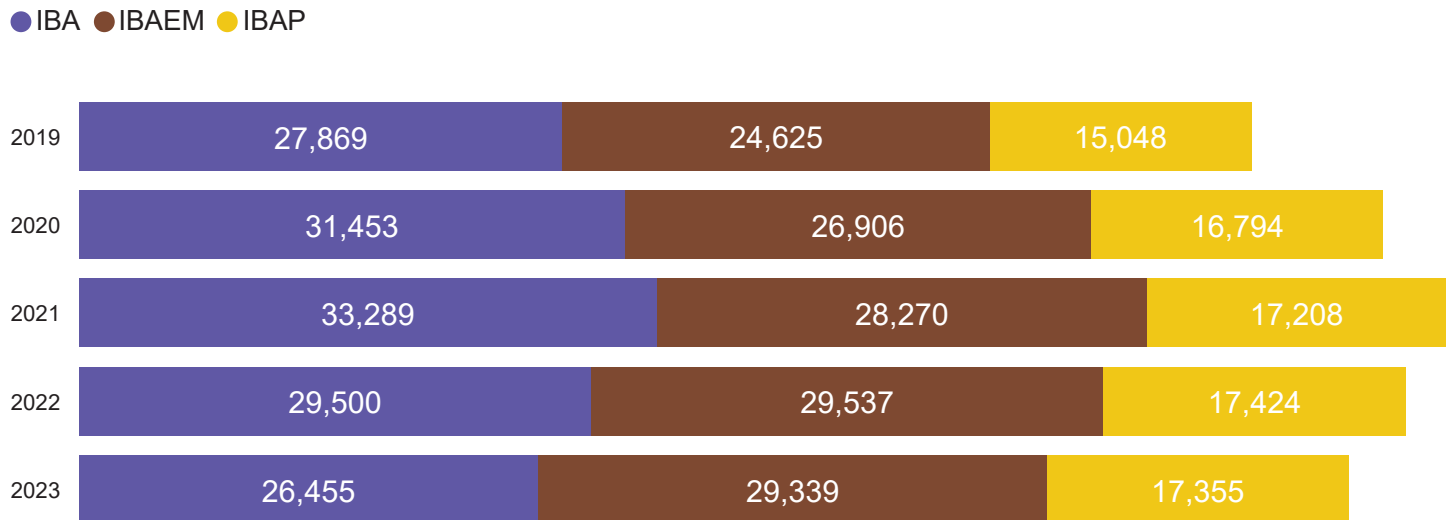

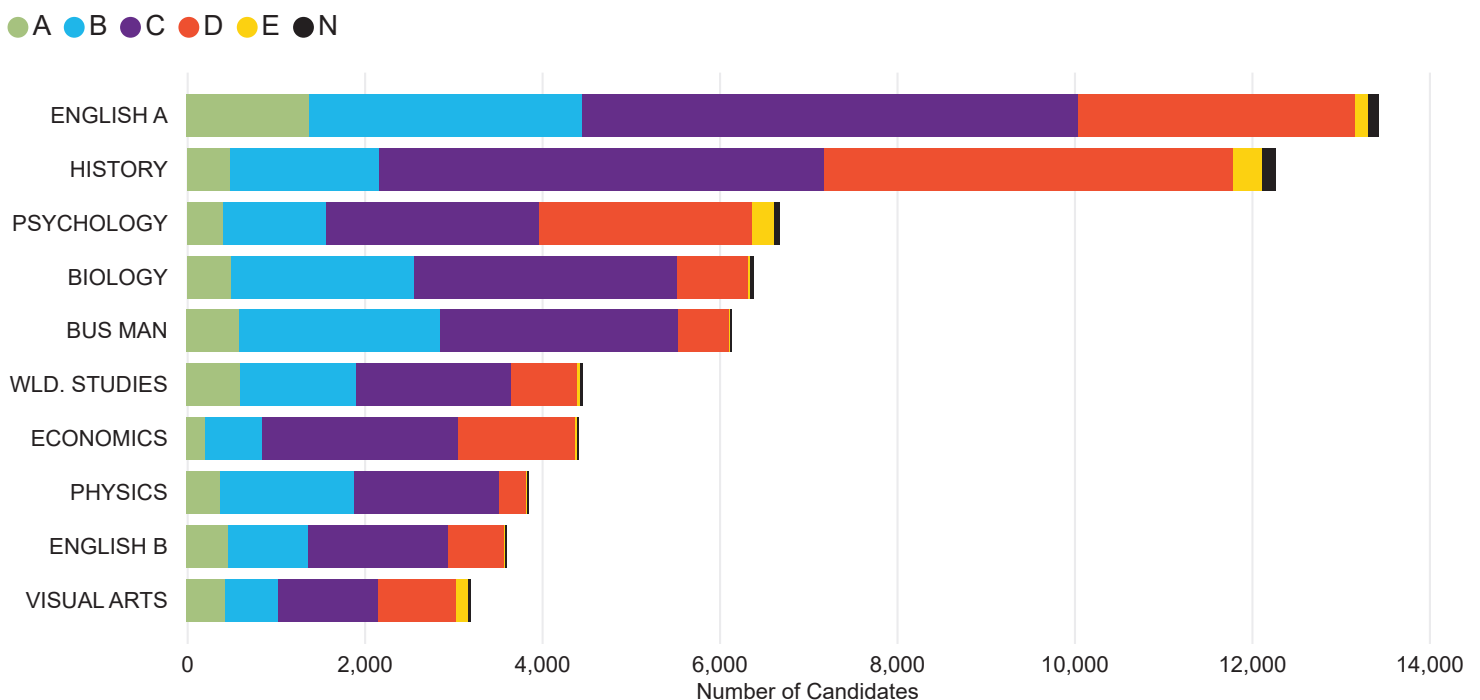

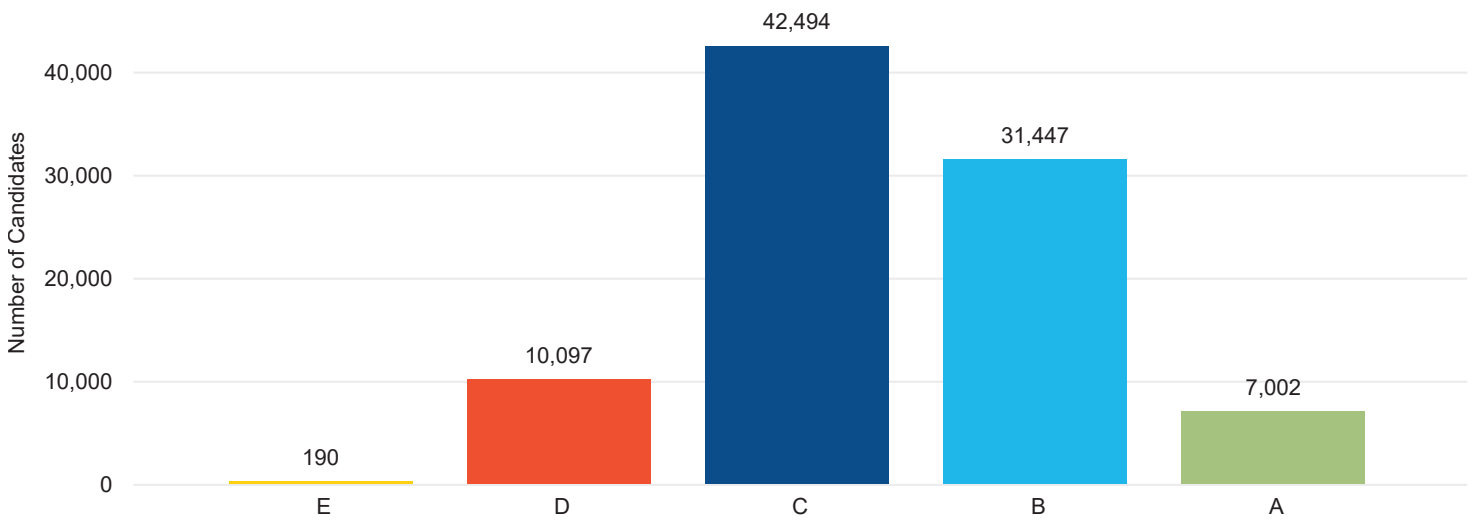

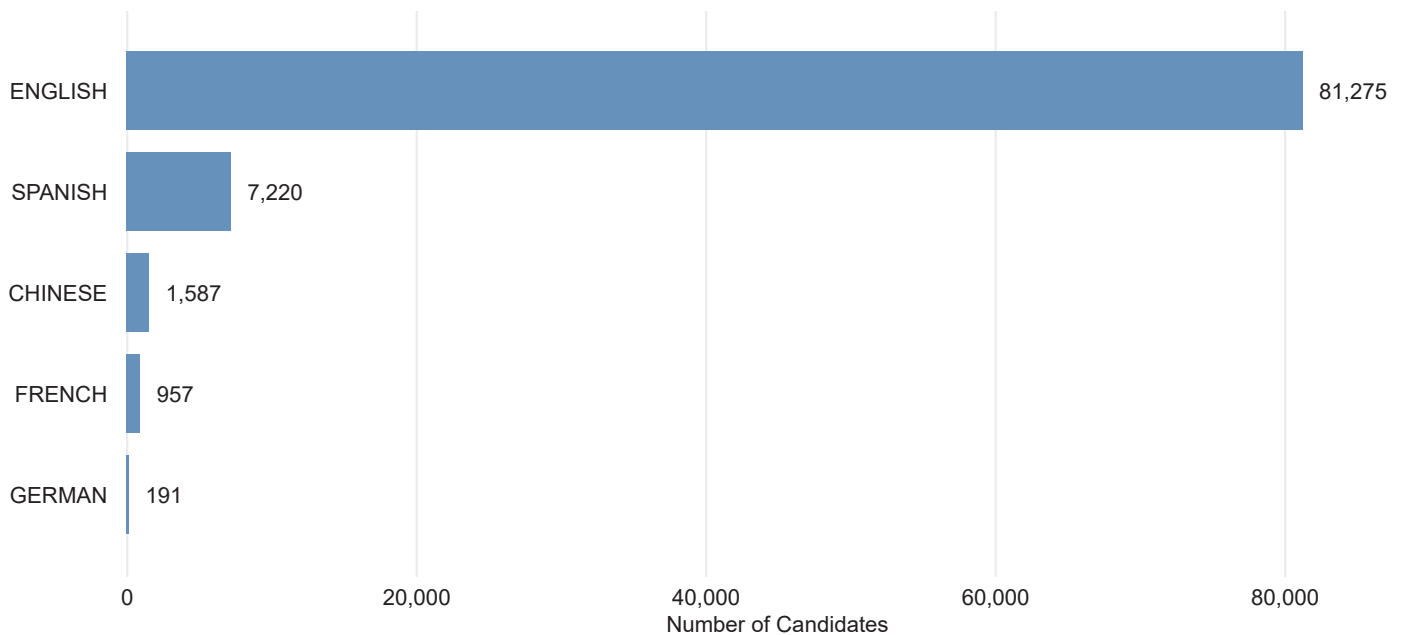

Number of Candidates by Language



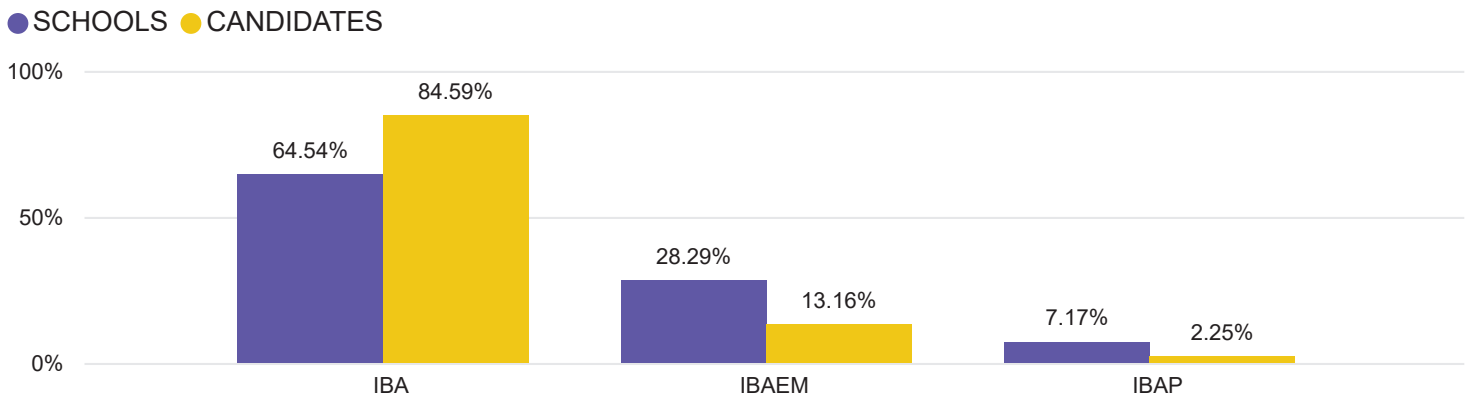

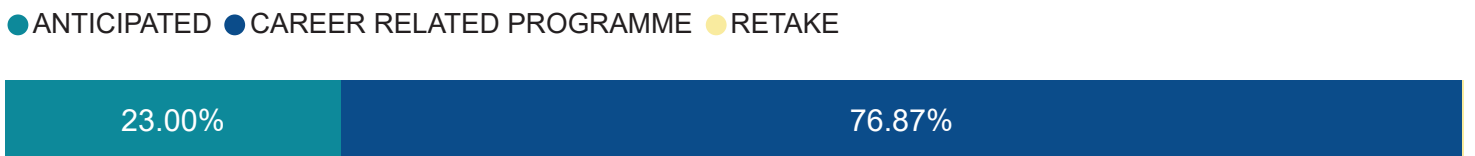
Regional Distribution of Schools and Candidates

Percentage Split by Category



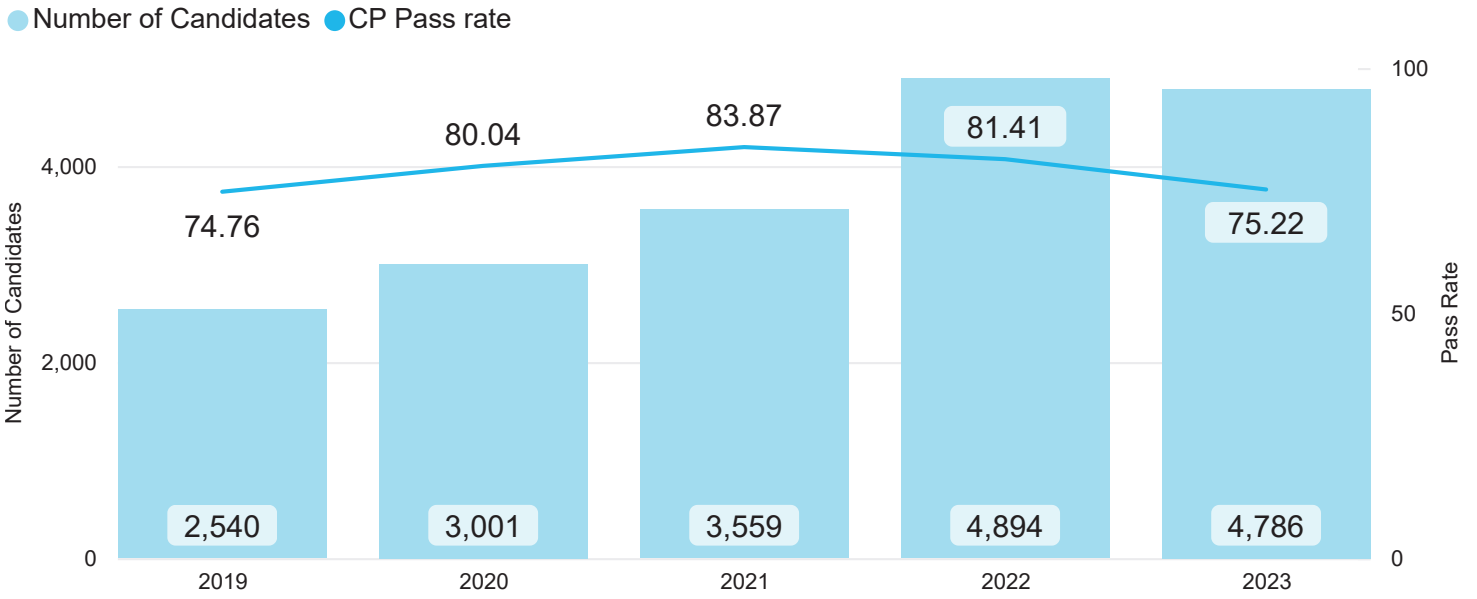
Distribution of Schools by Legal Status



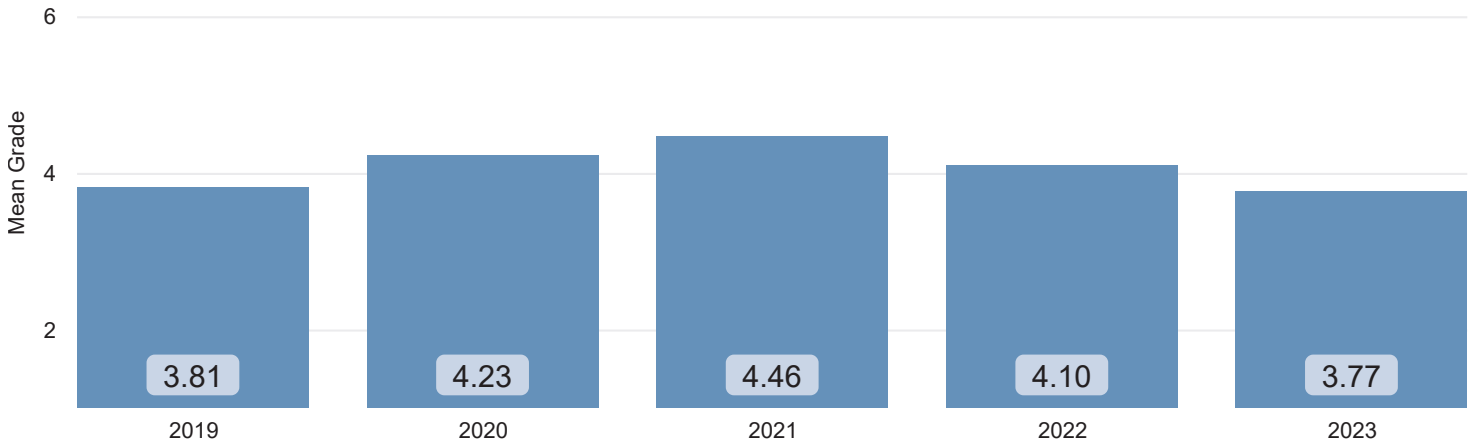

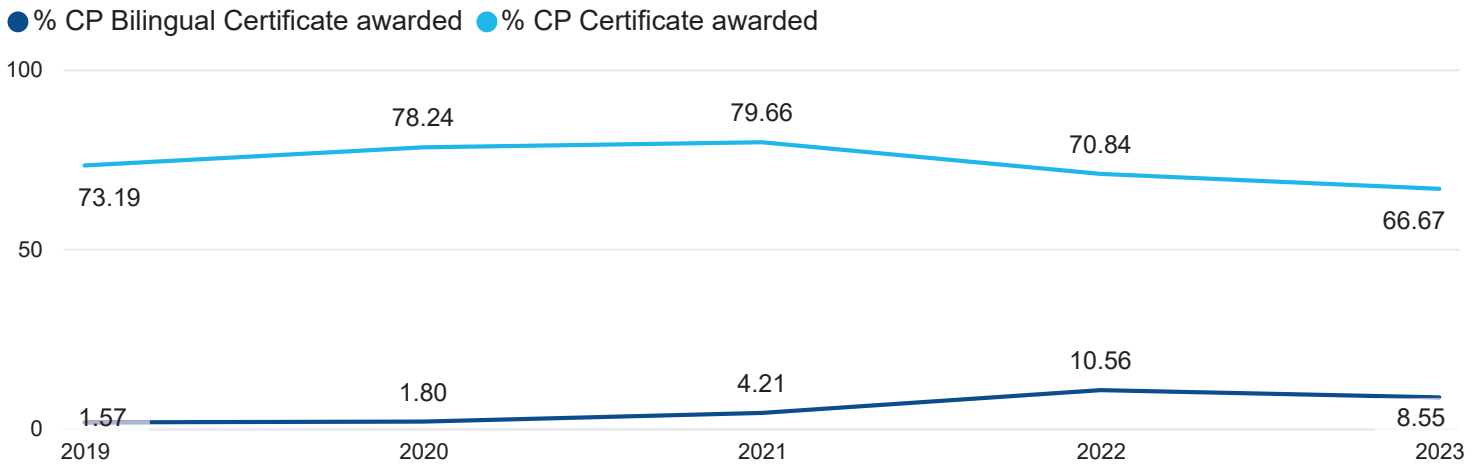
## Number of Candidates and Pass Rate

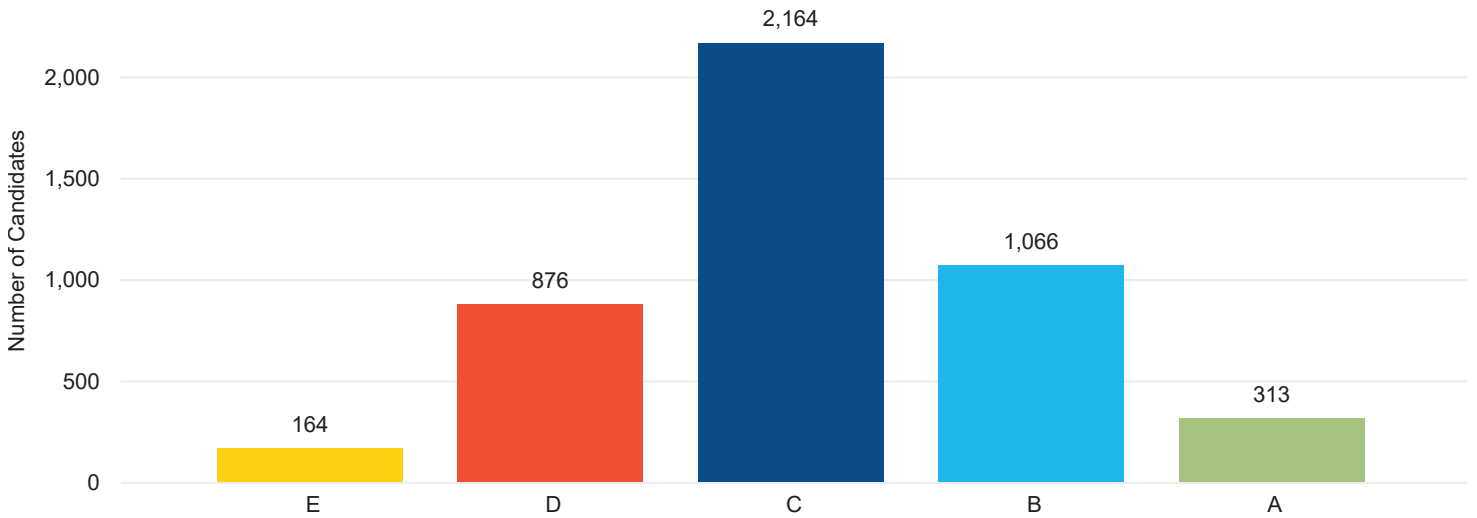

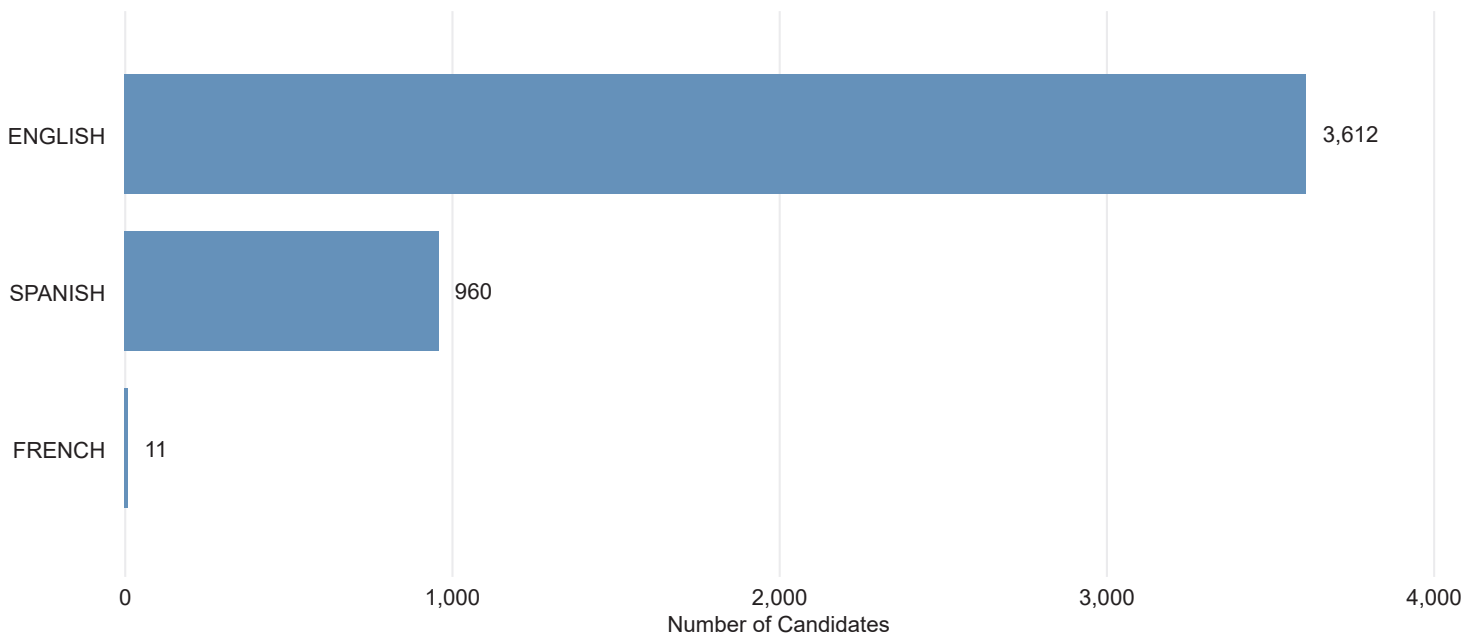

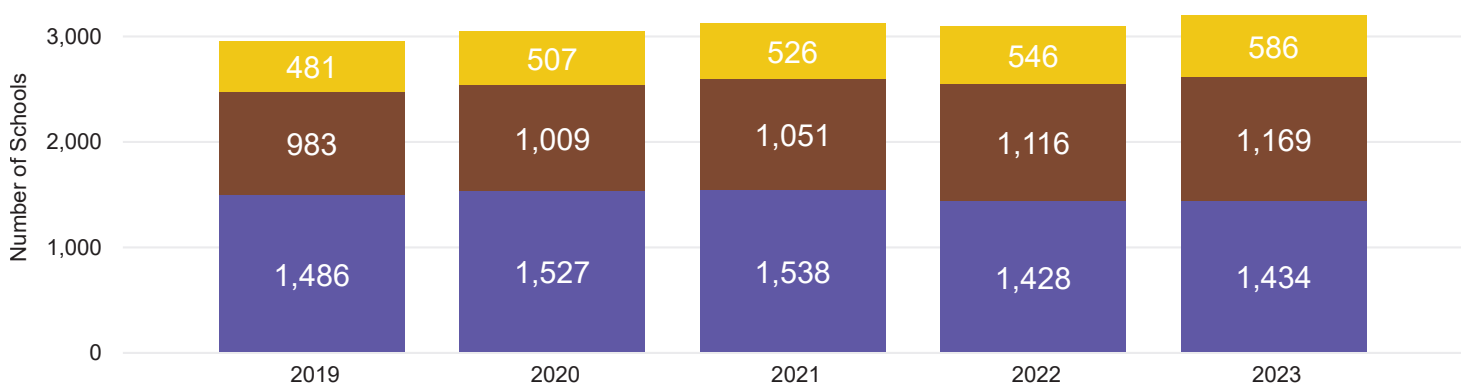

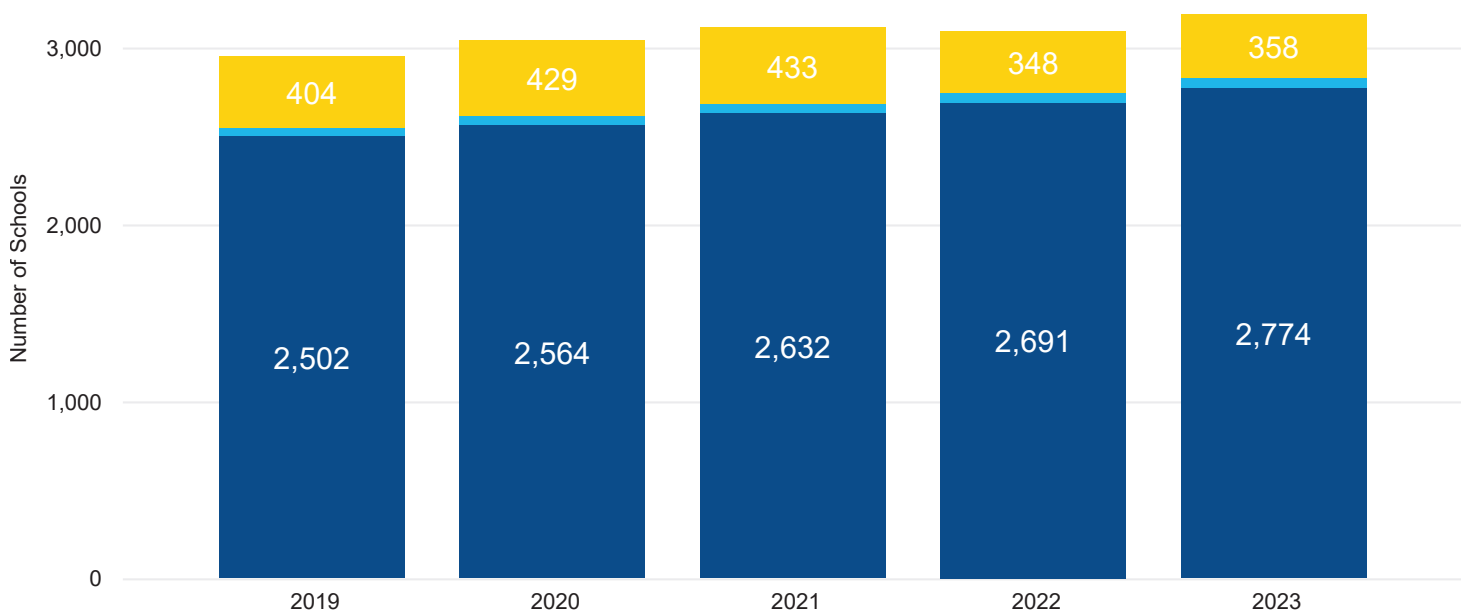
Number of Schools by Region

● ENGLISH ● FRENCH ● SPANISH



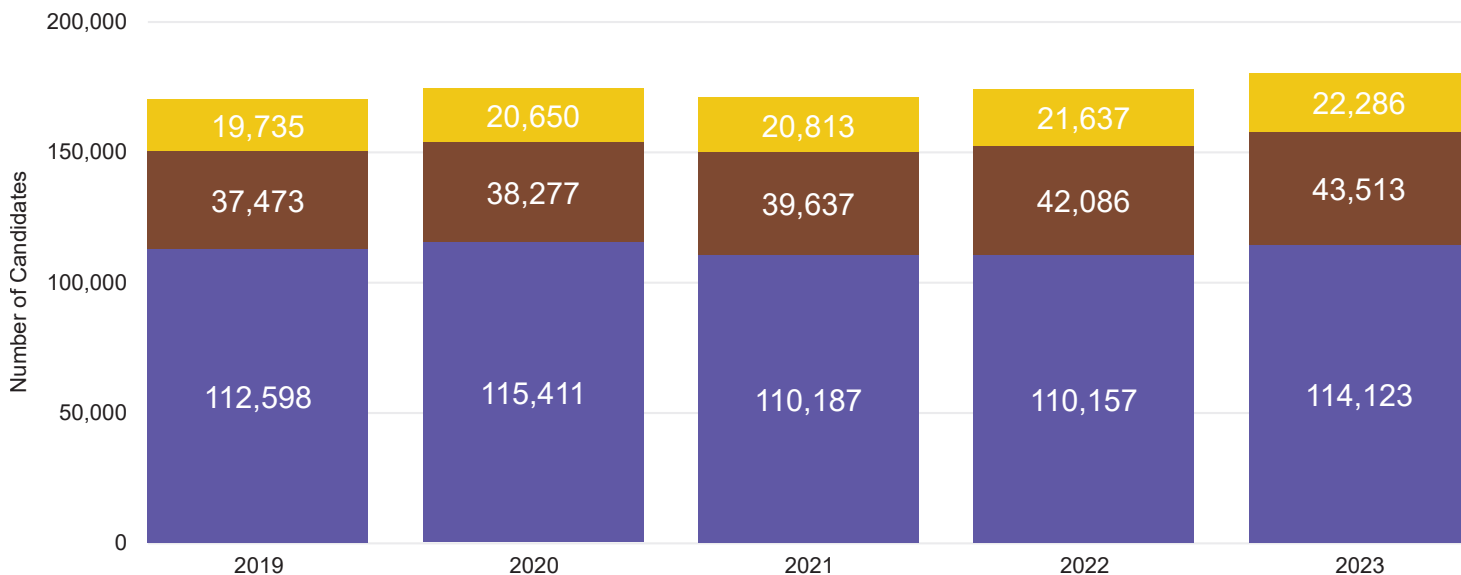

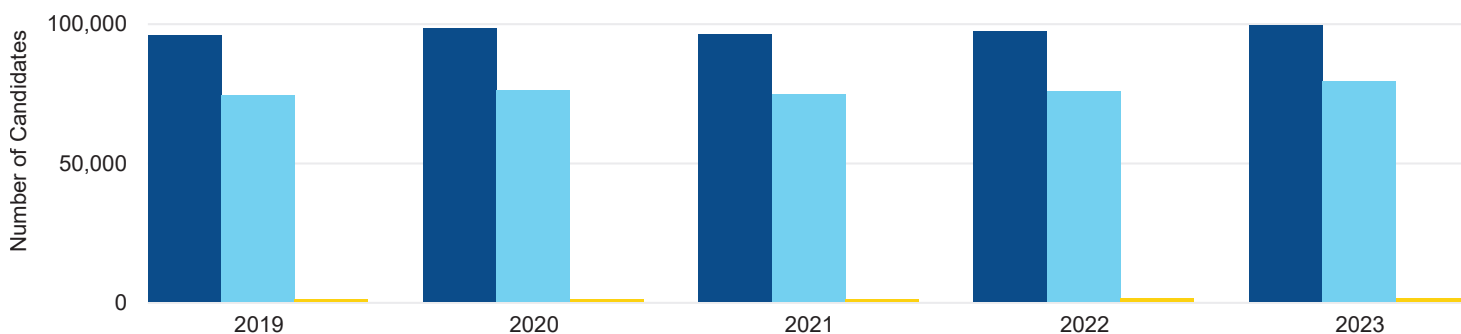
## Number of Candidates by Region
