Central Idea

Signs and symbols are used to communicate a message.

Lines of Inquiry

- signs and symbols;
- reasons for signs and symbols;
- features used to communicate locally and globally.

Overview:

This term in Visual Arts students in Reception have explored the visual features of signs and symbols and the messages communicated through the elements of design - colour, shape and line.

Students have explored feelings created by the elements of design, examined and re-created signs and symbols used in the Aboriginal culture, the weather, the environment and in our art room.

Through these learning activities students have developed their artistic skills and knowledge in collage, painting, printing, colour, shape and line.

The final summative task gave students the opportunity to design a sign for either an art room Essential Agreement (classroom rule) or a material / tool using the technique of collage.
