



How to apply to the Ukrainian University if you graduated from the Eastern Partnership School in Tbilisi

This instruction is only relevant for citizens of Ukraine who completed general secondary education abroad between September 1, 2020 and November 30, 2021 (dates may change each year)

Entrance procedure is defined in [Conditions of admission to higher education in 2021](#), annually approved by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine (MoES)



Option 1 - free (under state or regional order) External Independent Testing (EIT) is mandatory for entrance



Option 2 - paid (contract form) EIT or Entry exams in University

ATTENTION! IB Diploma recognition procedure is mandatory (see: [Recognition procedure](#) or infographic below)
You should apply for the recognition procedure to the competent authority (MoES or University where the student is enrolled) the latest by the end the first month of training

- 1 register for External Independent Testing (EIT) - *usually in February* (see: testportal.gov.ua)
- 2 personally submit applications to Universities - (**ATTENTION!** only paper applications are available in 2021 for IB diplomas holders)
documents to be submitted with paper application:
 - ID-card
 - IB diploma
 - military registration document (if necessary)
 - 4 photo cards (size 3x4 sm)*University may require additional documents (in the University's Admission Rules) depending on specialty or competitive offer*
- 3 pass Entry exams (if necessary - in case if an applicant didn't pass EIT) - only paid (contract) form
If number of points obtained for each exam is enough (exceeds the minimum level set by the University) applicants can participate in the competitive selection
- 4 get recommendation from the University to enrollment (for free form deadlines are determined in [Conditions of admission to higher education in 2021](#); for paid (contract form) - in the University's Admission Rules).
- 5
 1. personally submit documents necessary for enrollment (originals only) to University's Admission commission
 - IB diploma with all available amendments
 - EIT certificates and/or other relevant documents
 2. conclude a study agreement with the University (parents sign the agreement for entrants under 18 years old)

NOTE: other possible options to submit documents:

 - send by post addressing to University's Admission commission's official address;
 - send e-signed scanned copies to University's Admission commission's official email
